Nominating Committee

Nominating Committee Needs Your Help

The 2024 Nominating Committee has been working since May to find candidates to run for 4 board positions. Currently, we have candidates for 2nd Vice President and Secretary. We have made announcements at every guild meeting, and we're spoken to almost everyone in the guild, but we still do not have candidates for President and Treasurer.

We understand that everyone is focused on the 2024 Quilt Show, but we are getting very close to when we need to present our slate of candidates to the membership and vote for these positions. Anyone who fills a position will have the support of the previous position holder and the current board to ensure they're comfortable with the responsibilities of the position.

What happens if we DON'T have nominees for President & Treasurer?

If no one steps up to serve in these positions, we are at risk of losing our 501(c)(3) status. What this means is we would have to regroup as a non-charity organization, losing the benefits of being a 501(c)(3), including all the money we have. That money will have to be redistributed to another charity organization if we do not meet the criteria for being a 501(c)(3) organization.

There is a sense of urgency at this point to find qualified candidates for President and Treasurer. The committee needs to present the slate of candidates at the October meeting.

We are sincerely asking for members who could fill these positions to reach out to one of us to add their name to the ballot or nominate someone whom you think might be appropriate for these positions.

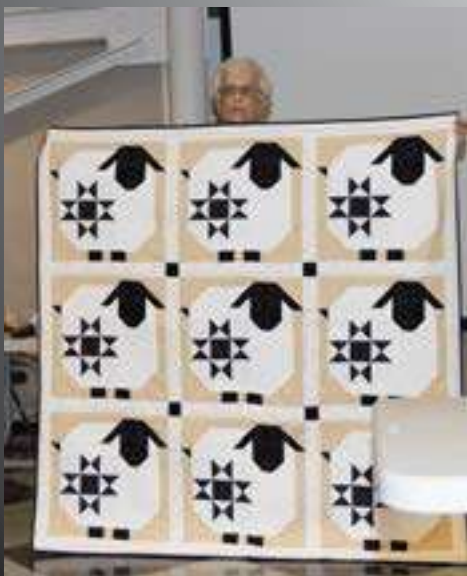

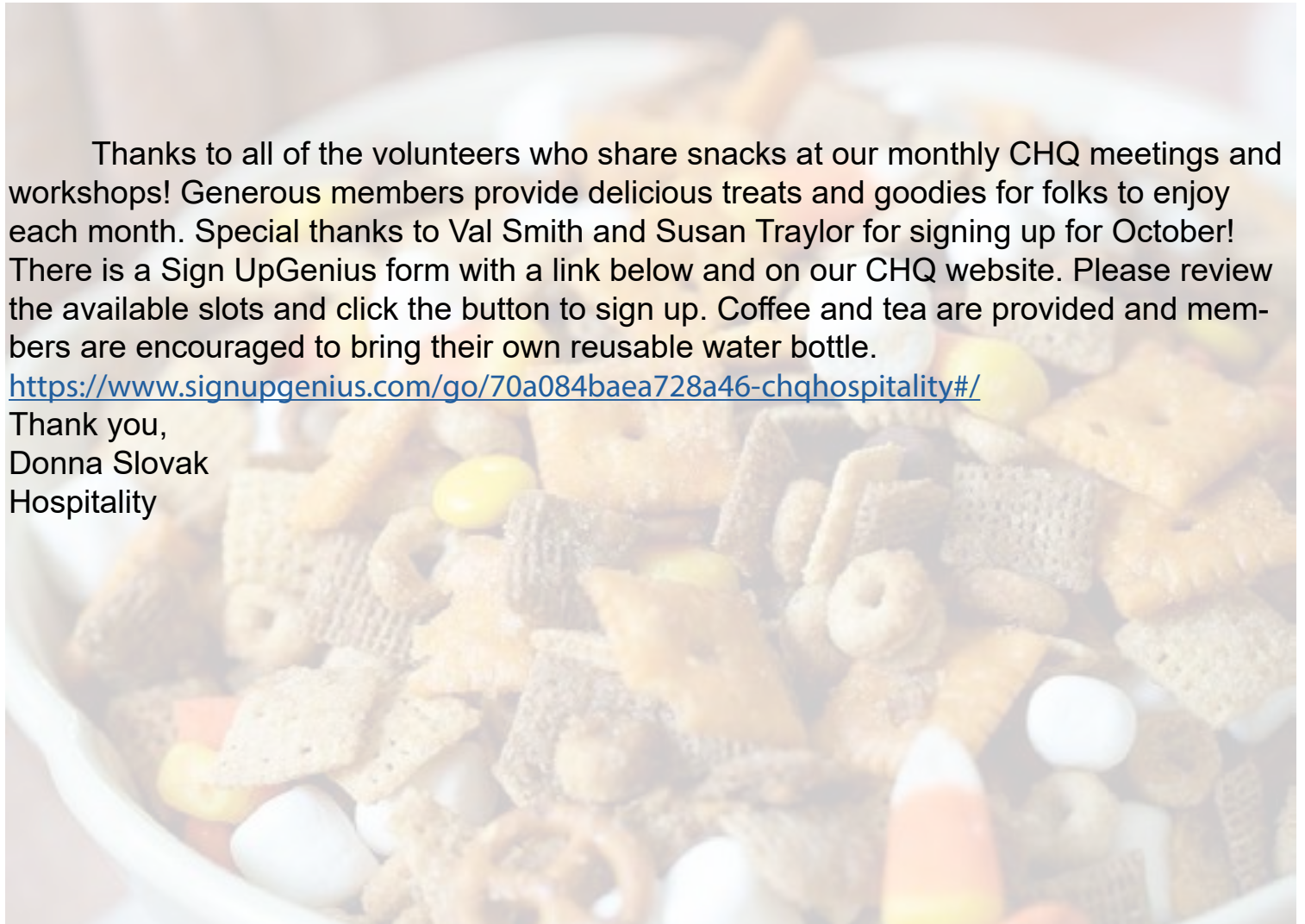

CHQ Board Meeting Minutes July 19,2024

Friday, July 19 · 7:00 – 7:56 PM ZOOM

In Attendance: Gina Krejsa, Laura Kohl, Patty Gertz, Barbara Fusco, Barbara Slaton, Donna Slovak, Penny Armagost (Non-Voting), Cass Garner (Non-Voting), Al Accettola, Dyan Rosario, Lysa Martinelli, Lauren Pine, Jan Hunold.

Gina Krejsa called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

June Board Minutes: Barbara Fusco made a motion to approve the June minutes, Al Accettola seconded the motion. Approved unanimously, eight (8) board members were present at time of approval vote.

Old Business:

- Nothing to report.

Board/Committee Status:

- **President:** Gina Krejsa
 - Gina Krejsa nominates Jan Hunold as the circulation chair. Donna Slovak seconded the motion. Approved unanimously by nine (9) board members.
 - Ad-hoc committee researched the payment of sales tax by members who were participating in consignment. The governing rule from the NJ taxation site for non-profit states that we are not required to collect sales tax for boutiques and caring hearts quilts. For member consignment the rules are not clear, so the committee considered consulting a non-profit tax professional which would cost as much as potential revenue so the decision was made not to pursue at this time.
- **Treasurer:** Kerry Cogen (Not present)
 - Kerry is looking into an electronic payment device that connects to The Mill WiFi to be used to process electronic payments at the mill. The guild is looking into purchasing two, one paid for by the show budget and the other from the board budget. This would require increasing the Board budget.

Patty Gertz moved to amend the board budget to provide an increase. Al Accettola seconded the motion. Approved unanimously by ten (10) board members.

 - October will ask members to speak on Quilting as a business

Gina Krejsa called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

July Board Minutes: Jan Hunold made a motion to approve the July minutes, Al Accettola seconded the motion. Approved by nine (9) board members, one (1) abstained because she was not present at the July meeting.

Old Business:

- Nothing to report.

Board/Committee Status:

- **President:** Gina Krejsa
 - Discuss which budget should be used to pay for the Paypal POS terminals used for electronic payment that were purchased by the guild. Dyan proposed since the units could be used for UFO auction, membership and programs after the show the payment should come out of the board budget for both units.

Dyan Rosario made a motion to allocate payment for both Paypal POS terminals from the board budget. Lysa Martinelli seconded the motion. Approved by seven (7) board members.

Gina Krejsa motioned to increase the board budget to pay for the second unit. Dyan Rosario seconded the motion. Approved unanimously by ten (10) board members.

- In the last amendment of the bylaws, the committee chairs were appointed for two (2) years. Will discuss in the next monthly meeting that all chair positions are opened and give chairs the option to retain their chair if no one expresses interest. The new board should appoint the new chairs, and reappointment should occur in a staggered manner so not all chairs are up for re-appointment at the same time. We will revisit this in a future meeting.

- **Treasurer:** Kerry Cogen
 - Balance has decreased because Mill rental payment has been taken out along with payment for the Paypal POS terminals for electronic payments and some printed materials for membership. We have incoming payments from member sales for raffle tickets.
