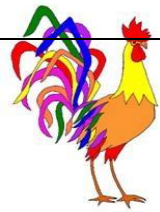

Rector's Letter to the 4th Day

CURSILLO #160

For this is what the Lord has commanded us: "I have made you a light for the Gentiles that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth." (Acts 13:47)



My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

De Colores! How amazing to be preparing for Cursillo #160 and to be filled with such peace, and I mean the kind of peace that passes all understanding! 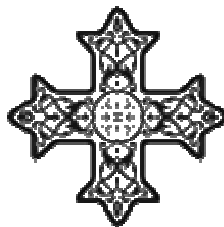

FROM INTERSTATE 26 - EXIT 203 (College Park Road)

- TURN LEFT if coming from EAST; TURN RIGHT if coming from WEST.
- Follow COLLEGE PARK ROAD, across US 78 to LADSON ROAD.
- Turn RIGHT onto LADSON ROAD.
- Travel 4.8 miles to DORCHESTER ROAD.
- Turn LEFT onto DORCHESTER ROAD (SC 642). Travel 1.8 miles.
- After THIRD light, St. GEORGE's will be on left, just before overhead power lines.

FROM INTERSTATE 26 - EXIT 209 (Ashley-Phosphate Road)

- TURN LEFT if coming from EAST; TURN RIGHT if coming from WEST.

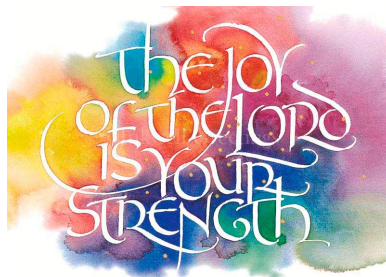
