DISCUSSION: Mayor Blakely shared Delcambre won Cleanest City contest for District III Category D and are in the finalist for State.





MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier, "moved to approve millage for Iberia Parish and Vermilion Parish at the maximum rate of 6.510 mills by complying with the 'roll forward' process/requirements." Motion Carried.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderwoman Madison Saunier and seconded by Alderwoman Sarah Trahan, "moved to approve Youth Work Program as presented by Rachell Duhon of Louisiana Workforce Commission. WIOA Internship & Summer Internship Business will provide workers for the Town with no liabilities to the Town. WIOA will screen all employees and suggest for approval to work. Town Department Heads will supervise participants during regular business hours. All pays will be provided through the program and at no expense to the Town." Motion Carried.
