## Town of Stratton Selectmen's Meeting June 26, 2017

**Present:** Selectmen: Al Dupell, Larry Bills, Chris Liller, Greg Marcucci and Kevin Robinson; Road Foreman – Ralph Staib and Clerk – Kent Young.

Al Dupell called the meeting to order at 7:30pm. Orders were reviewed and signed. No Modifications to the agenda were made.

**Rec. Area: Ball Field Electrical**: The Selectmen reviewed an easement between the School District (which owns the Recreation Area) and Green Mountain Power (GMP) for the new electrical service to be installed at the Rec. Area. An Agreement was also drawn up between the Town of Stratton and GMP to add this new service in the ball field area for \$6184.00 (the Town will be required to do the digging) – as approved at the previous meeting. Al Dupell signed the agreement. Kent Young signed as a witness. The Clerk will forward the agreement to GMP for their endorsement. Pavilion: Chris Liller stated that All Seasons Construction is interested in also providing an estimate for construction of the pavilion, but will not be available to do so until after the July 4 holiday. Kent Young stated that he had informed the Wadsworth Company as well as Paul Bernard that the town will be accepting bids for this project in the near future.

**Road Crew Issues:** Stratton-Arlington Rd. Culverts Project: Ralph Staib said that installation of said culverts has begun; however, the weather has and will hinder progress. **Paving**: Ralph Staib informed the Selectmen that Paving has been completed on West Jamaica Rd.. They also paved over a culvert crossing on Mountain Rd. that had settled.

**Town Contracts**: The Selectmen reviewed and signed a contract with Dana Bemis for Roadside Mowing, as per the previous bid agreement accepted by the Selectmen on May 8, 2017.

**Minutes:** Greg Marcucci moved to approve the Selectmen's Minutes of June 12, 2017. Larry Bills seconded the motion. All concurred and the minutes were approved.

Adjourn: Chris Liller motioned to adjourn at 7:45p.m.. Greg Marcucci seconded. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned.
