‘A Burning Bush or A Bright Light’

Exodus 3:1-3 - I must go see it.

The life of Moses in three parts:

- Prince of Egypt
- Shepherd of Midian
- Prophet of Israel

Life of a shepherd – lot’s of sitting and watching

Life Lessons from Moses:

1. He was attentive – “Moses stared in amazement.”
2. He was inquisitive – “Why isn’t that bush burning up?”
3. He was active – “I must go see it.”

Characteristics of Moses’ action:

1. He did not doubt – believed what he saw
2. He did not worry – left the sheep behind
3. He did not count the cost – what if he was wrong?

Moses took a chance. It was the right decision. What happens when the decision is wrong?

Acts 9:1-7 – Saul and the road to Damascus

Revelations 3:14-22 – Do not be lukewarm
Taking the right action is being hot
Taking the wrong action is being cold
Taking no action is being lukewarm

Taking action is buying gold purified by fire, garments of white to cover our nakedness and ointment for our eyes to see.”
