American Legion Riders

Spring has arrived with the hopes of wonderful riding weather; but as we know in Kansas the weather can be anything but what is expected. Additionally, the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic resulted in a "stay at home order", and the cancellation of numerous activities.

Nine of our riders attended the Iwo Jima 75th anniversary ceremony at the Leavenworth National Cemetery on March 7th. 10 (ten) of our riders participated in several of the events honoring Officer Michael Mosher, Overland Park police officer killed in the line of duty.

Nine riders participated in our ALR 407 ride to the Amsterdam Café on May 21st, and the weather cooperated. We anticipate that we will now be able to resume the following scheduled activities.

The Riders have scheduled rides for June 20 (Dam Fun Run) and July 25 (Freedom Run). Our ride donation is \$10.00 per person (rider, passenger or cage). KSU usually occur at 10am the morning of the ride; more details will be sent out closer to the day of the ride.
