

# Manifest

*“He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him” (John 14:21)*

The Word Manifest here is translated- show, exhibit, reveal, and disclose, it is so strong that it implies a manifestation perceivable by human senses. The love of God isn't just a warm feeling towards you. His love was made manifest in the life and death of Jesus.

There is an important connection between you and God. When you were created, you were created to have a relationship with HIM. You are one of the primary reason that Jesus came to earth. God sent Jesus so He could manifest in your life.

You have been designed to respond to HIM. This truth has profound implications for your life. God desires to visit you and something significant happens when you respond to Him. Things change within you. Before you were formed in the womb, God knew you.

That means you are in some ways you unconsciously (consciously) responded to HIM. Today, He wants to manifest in your life to those you know. He set you up in a way that when you come to HIM, you'll find HIM.

The key word In John 14:21, is “Come”. It's your choice to allow Him to manifest in your life or not. God wants to use your life to testify to the reality of His love for others by demonstration, not just mere words!

Just as God's love is more than an emotion, your love towards others must be manifested through your life (actions, words, etc). The very heart of Christ's ministry was servanthood.

His manifest presence always comes down to the immeasurable love of God shown by serving others. God's love in you is your way to love others. And His manifest presence of God always comes down to the immeasurable love of God being displayed through you.

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
