Theme of the Week: Easter & Springtime Fun!

Art and Craft Activities:

1. Wine Cork Chicks



Wine Cork Chicks

Supplies: a wine cork, yellow paint, glue, orange/white construction paper, scissors, and a black sharpie.

If you don't have wine corks, you can use a half potato, milk or water bottle caps, etc.

Steps:

- 1. Dip the end of the wine cork into yellow paint and stamping it on a white piece of paper.
- Once the yellow paint dries, draw two little legs, feet and two dots for eyes on the chicks with the black marker.
- For this step child needs parents' help. Fold a piece of orange construction paper in half and cut out little triangles to make beaks. Glue one on each yellow chick.
- 4. The wings need to use the edges of the wine cork and kind of make little lines coming out from the sides.

2. Creating Colorful Eggs:

Colorful Eggs Activity:

Supplies: construction paper, any art medium (paint, dot art, crayons, chalk, markers,)

Steps:

- Cut egg shapes in various sizes. You can discuss which is the smallest. Which is the biggest? Line them up smallest to biggest.
- 2. Decorate your eggs using the art supplies you have on hand.
- 3. Possibly even paint with a Q-Tip to make it more interesting and to promote fine motor skills.
- 4. Finger painting works too!

Extension: Mail your eggs to someone special.



3. Creating Collage Bunnies



Bunny Fun!

Supplies: construction paper, streamers or tissue paper cut or town into squares, glue, marker or googley eye or construction paper eye, cotton ball or a pom-pom for a tail

Steps:

- 1. Cut a bunny shape out of construction paper.
- **2.** Cut or tear paper streamers or tissue paper into squares.
- **3.** Paint the bunny with glue.
- **4.** Stick the tissue paper or streamers on the bunny shape. Collage the bunny!
- **5.** Add an eve.
- **6.** Glue a cotton ball for the tail.
- **7.** Mount on a full size piece of construction paper and display.

Collage supports eye-hand coordination and fine motor skills and the pincer-grasp.

4. Additional Art and Craft Ideas:

These are great activities to discuss textures, soft, fluffy, hard, etc. The children should put the glue on the cotton ball and glue it to the base. The glue can be applied with a paint brush. These are good eye-hand coordination activities.

Paper Plate Bird Nest

Overview: The craft is a bird nest with two baby birds made of cotton balls and googly eyes sitting in the nest that is composed of scraps of paper and other materials Link:https://www.dltk-kids.com/animals/mbirdnest.htm
