

POLICY NO. 2019-1
STREET SIGN POLICY FOR THE VILLAGE OF INNSBROOK, MISSOURI

PURPOSE. To adopt a formal policy for installation of street signs on private roads within the Village of Innsbrook. This policy shall eliminate the recurring purchase of missing or stolen street signs within the Village setting a limit on the number of signs the Village will procure.

OBJECTIVE. On August 14, 2012 during the Board of Trustees meeting, Trustee Price made a motion to formally set a policy regarding the Village's responsibility pertaining to the replacement of street signs, with an unanimous vote of approval. To date, no such formal policy exists for the Village of Innsbrook. This shall serve as the formal policy regarding street signs.

PROCEDURE. The Village shall purchase a maximum of two replacement street signs after the original purchase and installation on private roads located within the Village of Innsbrook. After the maximum replacement of street signs, a letter shall be sent to each property owner on said private road informing them that the Village shall not purchase any additional street signs.

The foregoing policy is hereby approved and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Innsbrook, Missouri this 14th day of May, 2019 and effective immediately.
