Each November the members of SI Music City Nashville begin making small donations daily based on denying some small pleasures or paying small amounts for things they take for granted. On December 10th following a full month we collectively donate that money toward the International President's Appeal. President Yvonne Simpson's 2015-17 Appeal is in support of education initiatives for women and girls of Nepal. Nepal is amongst the poorest and least developed countries in the world, with approximately one-quarter of its population living below the poverty line, women being the poorest with little education, resources, and mobility. Focusing on the SI theme of Education and Leadership the appeal will assist women and girls in rebuilding their lives following the April and May earthquakes in Nepal. Building partnerships with leading educational organizations working in Nepal, the appeal will create public awareness opportunities for SI and the Federations.
