

Why UFO's Cannot Be Aliens From Outer Space

(A Concise Outline of the Facts)

In today's time, more people believe in space aliens than they do the existence of God. The reason for this is because of the multitude of documented UFO sightings, crop circles, abductions, cattle mutilations, etc. There is also a bit of history that might lead some to believe they exist; especially when one looks at the history of ancient civilizations such as the Mayans and the Aztecs. All of these things that I have mentioned are verifiable. It is definitely the case that, within the wide spectrum of hoaxes, there are many true instances of the above phenomena. So, with this in mind, what is going on? Well, I can tell you one thing: there are *definitely* NO such things as "aliens from other planets". To illustrate this conclusion, I am going to briefly reference a few key points below.

1. In their book *The Anthropic Cosmological Principle* physicists Barrow and Tipler list ten steps in the course of human evolution, each of which is so improbable that before it would occur the sun would have ceased to be a main sequence star and would have incinerated the earth. They calculate the probability of the evolution of the human genome to be somewhere between four to the negative 180th power to the 110,000th power and four to the negative 360th power to the 110,000th power. The conclusions that one can draw from this are as follows:
 - a. If evolution did occur, it seems to have *miracle* written all over it. Although, perhaps this planet just happened to hit the lottery?
 - b. The problem, when one factors in "aliens", comes from realizing that, even if we happened to hit this lottery, the idea that other planets hit the same lottery raises the first miraculous improbability exponentially; especially when *multiple* "alien races" are speculated. These observations seem to completely eradicate the possibility of alien life, no matter how big the universe might be. I suggest researching the "fine tuning" of the universe for further details.
 - c. Oddly enough, many scientists believe that since evolution *is* so improbable and full of holes, aliens must have "seeded" us on to this planet. The problem with this hypothesis is as follows: if we already have a miraculously improbable life supporting planet to start, and we were *not* able to form on our own, then how did the aliens form on their own?
 - d. Conclusion from this: UFO's *cannot* be aliens from other planets.

2. UFO's Break the Laws of Physics
 - a. Alien crafts are documented in breaking these laws by doing some of the following things:
 - They cut right angles at extremely high speeds
 - They go extremely fast without making sonic booms
 - They are able to pass through solid matter
 - b. With this in mind, we must recognize that all attempts to disprove the current physical laws have failed. At this point in time, these laws are still holding strong, and so these "breaks" reinforce the conclusion drawn from the probability factors mentioned above. These entities cannot have originated within this universe.
 - c. Conclusion from this: UFO's *cannot* be aliens from other planets.

What then do we make of these UFO's and alien encounters?

1. Mayan and Aztec Alien Reports (*Analyzed and Compared*)
 - a. The Mayans and Aztecs both described one of their main "gods" as a flying "feathered serpent". The names were Kukulcan for the Mayans and Quetzalcoatl for the Aztecs.
 - b. These "gods" also required many human sacrifices in order to receive the "knowledge of the gods".
 - When compared to the Bible:
 1. There is also a detailed account of a flying serpent, sometimes referred to as a dragon. This figure is known by a few names, mainly Satan.
 2. This serpent also sought for humans to sacrifice themselves on many different occasions.
 3. A more famous passage, in the beginning of the book of Genesis, depicts this serpent as deceiving humans into thinking that they needed to try to obtain godlike knowledge. Like many New Age religions, this serpent was putting out the deception that they could become "as gods".
2. Alien Abductions and Cattle Mutilations (*Analyzed and Compared*)
 - a. There are many cases of alien abductions in the world, and they are almost always unwanted and unpleasant experiences in which one's body is taken over. These abductions also involve invading the body in some way, and *implanting* something inside the human body.

- b. When it comes to the much-documented cattle mutilations, each case seems to show a distinct pattern of complete draining of blood and one or more organs removed from the animal's body before it is dropped back down to the ground. These organs (hearts, brains, eyes, etc.) seem to often be removed without leaving signs of any invasive surgery. (Again, the breaking of physical laws)
 - When compared to the Bible:
 1. There is also a very similar form of unwanted abduction in the Bible, and it is called demonic possession. This also involves taking over a body, and *implanting* something demonic within that body.
 2. In terms of mutilations, the Bible also speaks of evil blood sacrifices involving animals, adult humans, and children. These horrific situations were occultic, and they are depicted as being part of satanic rituals. As with the Mayans and Aztecs, the Bible literally depicts people passing their own children "through the fire" in order to appease their "gods".
3. Human & World Creation (*Analyzed and Compared*)
 - a. Whether it be within many New Age religions, or the accounts of Mayan and Aztec history, these "aliens" always make the claim that *they* created the universe, the earth, and the people within them.
 - b. The problem with this is that the probabilities mentioned in the beginning indicate that this can be nothing more than a lie. In fact, it is *impossible* for a material entity inside the universe to create the universe.
 - c. This indicates that these figures have a tendency to be extremely deceptive.
 - When compared to the Bible:
 1. There are also accounts of beings that *constantly* try to corrupt humanity at different historical times by means of technology, knowledge, and false belief systems. These beings are what are known as "fallen angels".

4. Breaking the Laws of Physics (*Analyzed and Compared*)
 - a. As mentioned above, these beings seem to be able to move swiftly through matter and space, minus the laws that we are all governed by.
 - When compared to the Bible:
 1. There are also accounts of beings that are able to move in the exact same way. These figures are interdimensional beings called “angels” or the “Sons of God”.

Another fascinating revelation can be found when one looks at the first of the commandments given to Moses in the Old Testament:

1. Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
2. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

When one analyzes this passage, one can see a few very key points. First, God is saying that there *literally* are things that describe themselves as “gods” that are in the sky, earth, and water. The next key thing to notice is that God is basically saying that if you bow down and worship these entities, terrible things are going to follow. Now, in thinking about the history of the world, isn't it interesting that the powerful civilizations that worshiped these “gods”, such as the Mayans, the Aztecs, the ancient Egyptians, the ancient Romans, the ancient Greeks, etc., all *were* eventually brought to ruin. In terms of just the Mayans and Aztecs, they were literally sacrificing their own people by the tens of thousands right up until they were wiped off the map. An interesting side note: like the ancient Egyptians, both the Mayans and the Aztecs lived amongst pyramids as well. Hmm. Interesting that all these separated civilizations knew to build pyramids; pyramids that we cannot even replicate today. Have you ever wondered why there are pyramids depicted on the back of the US dollar bill? Makes you wonder what certain people actually worship in this world? If we take the history of these ruined civilizations into account, and the fact that the “1%” prints the money, this seems to make the case that the pyramids must not have been built by anything that we might call benevolent. The Mayans and Aztecs actually sacrificed their own people on top of these structures, and the US seems to be following in their sacrificial footsteps by deeming those

greenback pyramids more important than human life. Perhaps *this* nation will be the next one to be brought to ruin?

Conclusion:

It is NOT scientifically possible that there are actually “aliens” from other planets. This means there has to be another explanation for all of the UFO phenomena in the world, and it cannot be purely “shadow governments” or anything of that nature, strictly because of the documented UFO ability to seemingly break physical laws. As odd as it may seem, the book that gives the most detailed explanation for all of these phenomena is the Holy Bible. The explanation given is that these beings are deceptive, demonic, fallen angels. Now, this doesn’t necessarily prove that the Bible is true, but it does give the best answer as of yet. In my view, though, the UFO presences actually authenticate the Bible to an even greater degree. Interesting side note: when one actually studies ancient histories, whether Mayan, Aztec, Greek, Roman, Egyptian etc., it seems to be the case that there is always a depiction of the *humans* needing to be sacrificed *for* the “gods”. When one examines this fact, it is extremely interesting that in the Bible it is the *God* that is sacrificed *for* the humans. In taking note of this striking detail, not only does the Bible seem to give the best explanation for UFO’s, but it also offers a counter story that is utterly unique within antiquity.

In closing, I would be very skeptical about what you might hear some “scientists” say, what the media is having you believe, or what the doctrines of some New Age religions teach. In researching these alien religions, I find it very interesting that these “beings from Pleiades”, or wherever, take the time to travel across the universe in order to belittle the divine nature of Jesus and debunk the Christian Bible. Long way to travel in order to make a claim that many other world religions, from Mormonism to Islam, already make. It seems there is a lot of interest in the universe to try to take down Jesus and the Bible; and, in the case of the New Age, it’s not even necessary to pay attention to Jesus because he is just one of *many* powerful aliens. This is a very intriguing claim. Even within religions, it seems that extraterrestrial aliens are everywhere you look. The truth is, though, that science and reality *both* indicate that aliens are actually nowhere. In fact, if you ever happen to witness a mass global “abduction”, and then you see “aliens” arriving on the planet, don’t believe *anything* they tell you. One of them may very well be hiding a pair of horns, metaphorically speaking, while trying to get humanity to take his “mark”, all the while espousing a false promise to take the evolution of humanity to the next level; a promise to make humanity “as gods”. If this ever happens to you, there will only be one-way out from this point: Rebuke them in the name of Jesus, and then ask Jesus for forgiveness. Better still, why not avoid all of this, and simply ask Jesus to come into your life now?

You may say that all of this biblical stuff sounds crazy, but lets be fair; a minute ago you actually *believed* it was possible for “ET’s” to be visiting the earth.
