



LAKE AGASSIZ REGIONAL ENVIROTHON SEPTEMBER 24 AT ICELANDIC STATE PARK

The Envirothon is North America's leading natural resource education program for high school students, emphasizing hands-on, team-oriented problem solving and community involvement that prepares young people for environmental careers and active citizenship.



Education Stations: Students and advisors rotate around 5 hands-on stations during the morning portion of the competition learning about soils, aquatics, forestry, wildlife, and prairie.



Trail Test: In the afternoon, teams of 5 students take a trail test based on information received during the education stations. Trail test questions are hands on and cooperative.



Networking and learning: Students have a chance to network with natural resource professionals and learn about potential future careers.



The ND Envirothon focuses on the conservation of forest, water, wildlife, prairies, and soil resources, and on community environmental issues. The envirothon is a great way to bring the classroom outside and works with many science curriculums.
