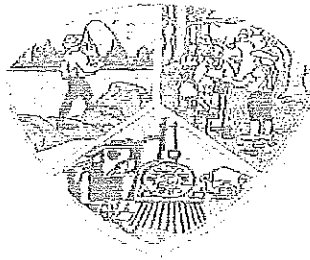

RECYCLES

What can you recycle?

The Hunterdon County Solid Waste Management Plan requires the following items to be recycled:

Hampton Borough Waste Management

WHAT	WHEN
Aluminum & B-Metal Cans	Tuesday Recycling (Do not put in plastic bags)
Glass Bottles and Jars (clear & colored)	Tuesday Recycling (Do not out in plastic bags)
Cardboard & brown paper bags	Tuesday Recycling (No waxed containers Ex: Milk/Juice ½ gallon containers, juice boxes)
Newspapers, Magazines, Junk Mail, Office Paper	Tuesday Recycling (Do not put in plastic bags) *Shredded paper is not recyclable
Plastic Bottles (#1-7)	Tuesday Recycling (Do not put in plastic bags)
Computer Equipment	Hunterdon County Division of Solid Waste & Recycling Check County website for dates and times
Propane Tanks	Hunterdon County Division of Solid Waste & Recycling Check County website for dates and times
Florescent Lighting Tubes	Hunterdon County Division of Solid Waste & Recycling Check County website for dates and times
Laser/Ink Jet Cartridges	Hampton Elementary School will recycle them Also Staples and Office Depot
Leaves	Place Curbside Oct. 5 – Dec. 14 Before or after these dates they must be bagged and tagged with "Extra Trash" stickers
Yard Waste	Bagged & Tagged with "Extra Trash" stickers
Scrap Metals	Contact Hampton DPW for appointment 908-537-6884
Textiles (clothing & Fabric)	Town Clean Up Day, also donation boxes at A&P and Youth Center
Motor Oil	Hunterdon County Division of Solid Waste & Recycling Check County website for Hazardous Waste Cleanup Day
White Goods (Large Appliances)	Contact Hampton DPW for an appointment to establish the number of required "Extra Trash" stickers 908-537-6884
Car Batteries	Hunterdon County Division of Solid Waste & Recycling or Padik Auto Parts, 423 Route 513, Califon, NJ (Batteries go on rack in front of the store 24/7)

AA, AAA, B,C,D & 9V Batteries	Regular Garbage as of February 2011 (Since 1997 these batteries had the mercury content reduced by 90% & are now considered safe in the landfill)
Rechargeable Batteries	Radio Shack, Best Buy, Staples
Lithium Based (Li-ion, Ni-Cd, Ni-MH)	Tuesday Recycling
Televisions	Call DPW for number of "Extra Trash " Stickers needed for Pick Up Best Buy will take televisions as well.

Any business located in Hampton Borough that generates these, and/or other waste items not listed here that are recyclable should do so annually providing the Hampton Borough Recycling Coordinator with recycling tonnage information .
