Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, East District Commissioner, Chet Owen, West District Commissioner, Kyle White and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed those in attendance and led all in prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve today's agenda and approve the minutes from the December 27th meeting with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Christy Humerickhouse of Veregy gave an update on Sunset Nursing Home. The Commission plans to hold an open house when construction is completed.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray met with the Commission and discussed equipment, brush, damage reported to a bridge and brush removal.

A patron met with the Commission concerning the brush removal cost that was added to his tax bill. The brush removal cost will remain on his tax bill.

Sheriff Kasey Keesaman met with the Commission and discussed his staff and issues around the County.

Accounts payable and payroll were reviewed and approved.

The Commission discussed the 3% marijuana sales tax that will be put on the April 4th ballot. This tax only pertains to the sale of marijuana and all funds collected from this sale will go into general revenue.

Alan Gillette Camden Township board member met with the Commission to discuss concerns the township had with a tube installed on Fairmount.

The Commission signed a document for Connell Insurance that allows us to pay our premium on February 1, 2023.

The Commission signed a proclamation urging the Missouri Legislature to amend the initiative petition process in Missouri.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek advised the Commission that she had halted TS Conard from having cabling technicians and heat maps completed for WIFI until further information is gathered.

The Commission approved continuing the contract with Attorney Ivan Schraeder and will look into the possibility of using MAC's attorney as well.

A patron met with the Commission to discuss the brush bill that was attached to his tax bill for 2022.

The Commission discussed no smoking around the building or at least no smoking at the entrances. The Commission will discuss this in depth during their January meetings where they will also discuss social media and marijuana policies concerning employees and DeKalb County properties.

With no other business before the Commission, West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn until January 3, 2023. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the second.
