The application is due on or before Sunday, May 5, 2019

Process to be considered for an Edward O. Lund Foundation Scholarship and receive an interview:

CRITERIA

- Recipient must be pursuing a degree in Studio Art, Art History, Graphic Design, Interior Design or the Single Subject Art Credential Program at CSU, Fresno throughout the full 2019-20 academic year
- Minimum 3.0 GPA is required
- Provide a personal statement of why study in London would be of value to you (BE CREATIVE - tell us your story in your own unique way)
- Address any financial need in statement
- Provide two letters of reference, with at least one being from a CSU, Fresno Professor in your major.
- Submit a minimum of ten images of your artwork via PDF or video, or two examples of your writing (if art history is your area of emphasis)
- To submit your application, place this completed application form, reference letters and artwork requirement in ONE compressed zip folder (labeled with your name) and send via Dropbox or email info@lundfoundation.org.

INTERVIEW PROCESS

- Once the above criteria have been met, and if you have been chosen as a finalist, the date and time of the interview will be confirmed with you by email.
- Interviews will be scheduled with the Edward O. Lund Foundation board the week of September 2, 2019
- On the day of the interview, students must be prepared to present and discuss their work, as well as how he or she will benefit from the London Study Abroad Program.
- The interview must be completed before a student can be considered for the scholarship.

PLEASE NOTE

- Students cannot be considered for Edward O. Lund Foundation Scholarship unless they are enrolled at CSU, Fresno August 2019 through May 2020.
- This application is to be completed only by students who are pursuing a major or master's degree in Studio Art, Art History, Graphic Design, Interior Design or the Single Subject Art Credential program at CSU, Fresno through Spring 2020.
- Awarded students will need to attend all London class orientation meetings in Fall 2019 before departing for the course December 27, 2019. The course typically lasts for 3 weeks.
- Successful scholarship recipients will be required to donate one piece of artwork to the Edward O. Lund Foundation, approved by its Board of Directors, to be auctioned at its annual fundraiser event held October 20, 2019. 100% of funds received for the artwork will be used solely for the foundation scholarship program. Scholars will also have the option to show additional artworks in future years.
