Work Experience

Requires 2 years of experience

- Code Inspections
- Plan Reviews
- Fire Code Inspections (new buildings)
- Fire Code Plan Reviews (new buildings)
- Construction

The following 2 years of experience will be accepted into the Building Program:

1. 468 licensed inspector/ plan reviewer working for less than 3 years.

Or

Building, Mechanical, Plumbing, Electrical, inspector or plan reviewer or Building Official certification issued by ICC, NFPA, IMAPO or similar nationally recognized code writing organization. Must Verify working full time for a jurisdiction and/or private provider.

2. Fire code inspectors and plan reviews certified under 663 F.S. who can verify inspections and plan reviews on new construction.

3. Construction Experience.

(a) Trades person as defined in 61G19-1.009 (8) FAC “*Experience*” means practical working experience as a trade person or construction, design or inspection industry professional, for compensation.

(b) Or Construction superintendents or construction project managers

4. Completed a 2 year Trade School Program in a construction related field.

5. 2 year degree in Architecture or Engineering as related to construction

NOTE: Upon completion of the 300 hour introduction program and licensing by the board, the student will be able to inspect residential and commercial building projects. It will be suggested that the student complete the Mechanical, Plumbing and Electrical (200+ hour) programs to inspect in the other trades.

Work Experience

1. Copy of 468 license Inspector or Plan Reviewer with less than 3 year experience

or

All requisite experience shall be verified by affidavit describing in detail each separate period of work experience listed in the application form, signed by a licensed architect, engineer, contractor, fire marshal, or building code administrator who has knowledge of the applicant's duties and responsibilities during the period indicated.

The form that shall be used for this purpose shall be provided by the department (BCAIB) and available on the department's (DPBR) website. Each affidavit must include the name and address applicant's employer, unless self certifying, of the applicant's duties and responsibilities during the dates on the application.

Include in the application: (if applicable)

- a) Certificate from an accredited trade school
- b) Copies of ICC or other certifications
- c) Other state licenses
- d) Military DD214

2. England Training LLC shall be responsible for review and verification of the applicant's experience prior to admission into the program and shall maintain a record of all verification documentation for not less than five (5) years.

3. England Training LLC will provide class records at the written request of the board on a case by case basis.

4. England Trainings LLC shall forward notification to the board after completion of the program. At that time the board shall issue approval for the examination and/or license in building inspector category. Further board review of the applicant's experience is not required.

NOTE: Any false information given to England Training allows the Building Code Administrators and Inspectors Board to nullify and/ or repeal the license.
