Adoption Application

Blue Bloods requires ALL applications be submitted with a \$20 processing fee, a copy of a utility or some other form of residence verification and photos showing, at a minimum: fencing, gates, pasture, a barn/shelter picture and picture showing the stall to be used for the adopted horse as well as other horses owned by the applicant or housed on the property. Blue Bloods may ask for additional pictures if details are unclear. Blue Bloods will not process applications in the absence of photographs and fee.

Applications will be accepted via email or postal mail.

The application processing fee can be paid by cash, check or online by visiting our website placement page and clicking the "Add to Cart" button.
