DEADLINE for COMPLETED (post-marked) Entry Form: Saturday, July 18, 2020

You need 3 copies of the entry form, 1 quilt photo and 1 copy of the instructions and rules page

- 1. For each quilt entered, submit 1 completed copy of entry form and a photo to be used to identify quilt to: Kathie Steele, 99 CR 1173, Sulphur Springs, TX 75482, postmarked by **July 18th, 2020** along with entry payment. Note: Incomplete entries will not be accepted into the show. Please print or copy or attach your photo on the back of the actual entry form that you submit.
- 2. Bring 1 copy of entry form along with your quilt to The ROC on Sept 12th between 8am and noon.
- 3. Bring last copy of entry form as a claim receipt to pick up your quilt on Sept 19, after 4:30 pm.

I. Quilt Acceptance Rules:

- a. All entry forms must be completely filled out, including CATEGORY NUMBER and OWNER SIGNATURE; none are optional. **Partially completed entry forms will not be accepted.**
 - b. Entries are accepted on a first come basis by entry due date and space availability.
 - c. Quilt cannot have been shown in the LSHQG Quilt Show in the past 2 years.
- d. The show committee reserves the right to re-categorize an entry or refuse to display an inappropriate entry.
- e. Required: 4" diameter sleeve stitched to the back top of quilt at 86" from the bottom; 2" diameter sleeve for Small Quilts. (Sleeve not required on Antique Quilts.)
- f. Quilts are to be clean, without pet hair and smoke free. Cleaning does not apply to antique quilts, but airing would be good.
 - g. Awards may not be given in each category, depending on the quality of the entries and/or number of entries submitted.

II. Instructions for Quilt Delivery:

- a. <u>Identification label is required</u>. <u>Baste identification label with name</u>, and title of quilt on lower back <u>corner of each quilt</u>.
 - b. Submit second copy of entry form when quilt is delivered to The ROC on Sept 12, 2020.
 - c. Alternately, quilts may be shipped/mailed to Wilma Moss, 950 Jackson St. N, Sulphur Springs, TX, 75482, to be received on or before September 12, 2020 with a copy of the entry form.

III. Quilt Pickup

Quilts can be picked up beginning at 4:30 PM, Sept. 19, 2020. Quilt owner (or their designee) must bring the <u>third copy of the entry form</u> to claim quilt. Out-of-town non-guild members will be first in line to pick up their quilts.

I understand that if I cannot pick up my quilt(s), I will have a designee, name and phone # on the front of my entry form, who will pick up my quilts at 4:30 PM, Sept. 19, 2020 at The ROC (First Baptist Church Recreation Outreach Center). NO EXCEPTIONS REGARDING PICK UP TIME. If you wish to have your quilt(s) shipped back to you, please enclose \$50 per quilt or prepaid shipping label for each quilt (UPS only).

LSHQG 2020 Quilt Show Categories

<u>The show committee reserves the right to re-categorize any entry</u>. Awards may not be given in each category, depending on the quality of the entries and/or number of entries submitted.

Category - Definition

100 - Bed Quilts, One Person -72" and greater on any side, machine or hand pieced, and machine or hand quilted. One person did ALL the work on the quilt - piecing, applique (if minimal - see category 300), quilting, and binding.

200 – Bed Quilts, Two or more persons - 72" and greater on any side, machine or hand pieced, and machine or hand quilted. Two or more quilters worked on the quilt– piecing, applique (if minimal – see category 300), quilting, and binding.

300 – Bed Quilts/Appliqued – 72" and greater on any side, machine or hand applique comprises 50% or more of the total quilt, machine or hand quilted.

400 – Wall Quilts – less than 72" on all sides, machine or hand pieced, and machine or hand guilted.

500 – Wall Quilts/Appliqued – less than 72" on all sides, machine or hand applique comprises 50% or more of the total quilt, machine or hand quilted.

600 – Small Quilts – less than 24" on all sides, machine or hand guilted, any technique.

Master Quilter definition: A Master Quilter has won 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in a juried quilt show or a quilt show with 300 or more quilts in the last 5 years. A Master Quilter may enter their quilts in the Master Quilts category, Art and Modern Quilts category or Other Techniques category.

700 – Master Quilts – Made by a Master Quilter.

800 – Art and Modern Quilts – any size quilt that is an original design that includes significant amount of non-traditional techniques and/or material as a major design element. Master Quilters may enter this category.

900 – Other Techniques – any quilt that does not fit into the 100-500 categories above. This includes white work, crazy, embroidered, cathedral window, yo-yo, rag, etc. Master Quilters may enter this category. (omitted hand applique)

1000 – Antique Quilts – any quilt made before 1960. Non-judged category.

2000 – Junior Quilts – Any quilt made by a quilt maker age 17 or under. Non-judged category.
