

ORDINANCE 1980 -3

Notice of Annexation to the Town of Cloverdale.

Notice is hereby given by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Cloverdale: Ordinance 1980 - 3 for annexation under (IC 18-5-10-19), the following Real Estate:

Situated in the State of Indiana, County of Putnam and being a part of Section 36, Township 13 North, Range 4 West, more particularly described to-wit:

4 West, Part of the South East quarter of Section 36, Township 13 North, Range 4 West, described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the middle of the Greencastle and Cloverdale Pike Road, which point is due west of the North line of the Morrison and Martin Addition to the Town of Cloverdale, thence East along the North line of said addition 46 rods to the West line of the lands formerly owned by James Broadstreet; thence North along said West line 17 rods 7 feet and 5 inches to a stake; thence West, parallel with said North line of said addition, 46 rods, more or less, to the center of the Greencastle and Cloverdale Pike Road; thence South with said Pike Road 17 rods 7 feet and 5 inches, more or less, to the place of beginning, containing 5 acres, more or less.

EXCEPT THEREFROM, Beginning at a point in the centerline of the Greencastle and Cloverdale Pike Road (old State Road 43,) which point is due West of the North line of the Morrison and Martin Addition to the Town of Cloverdale, thence from said point of beginning East 752 feet (former deed 759 feet) to the West line of Real Estate formerly held by James Broadstreet; Thence North 287.9 feet with the West line of said Broadstreet land; thence West 437 feet; thence South 8 degrees West 174 feet; thence South 64 degrees West 63 feet; thence North 62 degrees West 42 feet; thence South 68 degrees West 224 feet to the centerline of the aforesaid road; thence South 27 degrees East 24 feet with said centerline to the point of beginning, containing 3.65 acres, more or less.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage and legal publication.
