The September tournaments were scheduled for September 9th a wildcard and September 23rd on Ouachita, Best producing baits were a green pumpkin trick worm on a jig head, Other baits that were successful included a darter head jig with a salt and pepper dead ringer, top water, drop shot and Alabama rig.

The top three anglers for the September wildcard

tournament were: Greg Osterhout with 156 ounces, Dave Keith with 141 ounces and Mike Crews with 129 ounces. On the co-angler side the top three were: Bob Brannon with 136 ounces, Jim Retzer with 61 ounces and Norm Faustlin with 55 ounces.

Big bass on the Angler side went to Greg Osterhout with 50 ounces. Big bass on the co-angler side went to Jerry Swaim with 42 ounces.
