



On Sunday 3rd October, Liam Flanagan will be running the London Marathon in support of Bee-lieve Foundation, a charity based at Holy Family School. Bee-lieve Foundation work to support young people in coping with mental health & emotional wellbeing issues through providing resources and training for school staff alongside implementing whole-school teaching, assessment and tracking programmes. Bee-lieve are currently supporting over 20 schools in the local area and wish to extend this further over the coming 12 months. Liam, who was born 3 months premature and only took up running 4 years ago, is hoping to complete the 26-mile course in around 3 hours 35 minutes.
