Aloha Kakou,

Last month I wrote about how we in the Lutheran – and wider Protestant – movement read the Bible. To summarize, the Bible is a collection of sixty-six books that we understand as the word of God insofar as it points to Jesus, the crucified and resurrected Word of God.

The Bible is not a rule book or a metaphysical world that Christians must strictly adhere to. It is the story of God's rescue of Israel from Egypt and slavery in the Old Testament and the story of God's resurrection of the crucified Jesus from the dead. Pure and simple.

How we live in those stories is what our faith is about. As I have said in sermons recently, the grace of God, and God's call to us to live in that unconditional love, is the absolute we encounter in these biblical narratives. The particulars of that call in every time and place are fluid. How we live in God's grace in Christ depends on our context, our here and now. We do not use the Bible as specific worldviews for all time and eternity. Instead we listen for the values of the Reign of God that we discern in the stories of scripture ... values such as

- Equal regard for the Other;
- Mutual affection for each other;
- Self-sacrificial love, even for our enemies, especially those who would erase us.

Jesus offers us redemptive suffering in these stories, as opposed to redemptive violence. The Way of the Cross, not the way of violence, is the call of rescue and resurrection. We find our lives in losing them.

In these times of chaos and confusion, anxiety and fear, I invite you to go with me on this Lenten reflection. Easter is March 31<sup>st</sup>. Please join me on Wednesdays and online throughout the week as we ponder the great narratives and themes of our biblical tradition!
