Shipments of Icelandic Glacial Spring Water Moving at Full Steam

The Icelandic Glacial Spring Water is offered in TetraPak® bio-degradable 1-Litre cartons and packaged for On Guard for Humanity by Greencroft Bottling Co. Ltd., in Durham, U.K..

On Guard for Humanity donates the water to both refugee camps and local communities experiencing disastrous drinking water crisis.

Alberto de Sousa Costa, President and CEO of On Guard For Humanity stated: “This is a major humanitarian collaborative effort between the John A. Kufuor Foundation www.kufuorfoundation.org in Accra, Ghana, and On Guard for Humanity to reach-out to communities experiencing water distress throughout the Continent.”
