Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Garry McFee and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White and East District Commissioner, Garry McFee welcomed those in attendance and then Kyle Carroll led the group in prayer followed by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

East District Commissioner, Garry McFee attending a TIF meeting on June 25th in Cameron. The meeting was held to updated the members on current TIF projects and TIF projects currently in the program.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll attending a United Electric meeting where he asked about getting solar panels for the Courthouse. Due to the heating and cooling that is in place for the Courthouse building solar would not be cost effective.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray met with the Commission and discussed the need for a CB in the equipment, brush and work being done around the County.

Elizabeth Johnson representative for Senator Josh Hawley's office met with the Commission to introduce herself and see if the Commission had any concerns for the Senator. Discussion was had on the Corp of Engineers and the flooding issues in NW Missouri.

Bids will be advertised for work to be completed on the inside of the Courthouse. The work will entail ripping out carpet, repair of damaged walls and ceilings. Bids will be opened sometime in August.

At 1 p.m. a hearing was held by the Commission to finalize the closing of a road in Grant Township. The road closed is A PORTION OF KING ROAD BETWEEN NW LAKESITE AND NW MAPLE ROAD. All notices have been published and posted. Road is now closed on this day July 1, 2019. No patrons attended this hearing to dispute this closure.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn with East District Commissioner, Garry McFee making the second. Motion carried.
