No. 1 Trojans pound BA Tigers!

The top-ranked Trojans quickly took care of their district 6A-4 opponent, the Broken Arrow in front of 8500 fans at Jenks' Hunter-Dwelley Stadium shutting them out 38-0. This was the against Broken Arrow since Oct. 16, 1987 when they won 21-0.

Jenks racked up 451 yards in total offense. The Trojans scored on their first possession with and run between QB Andrew Brewer and WR Jesse Meyer. Brewer threw two other passes the night to Phillip Dillard and Teddy Andress. He finished 10-16 on the night for a season-l

On the ground, Freddie Carolina led the Trojans' ground game with 14 carries for 132 yards run down to the Tiger 8-yard line. Three plays later, Renard Johnson went left and scored f out. Steven Woodward also added a 26-yard field goal.

The Trojans racked up 247 yards on the ground and held the Tigers to just 122 on the ground offense. The Tigers also committed four turnovers with three of those being interceptions, without its turnovers though as the Trojans fumbled three times losing the ball twice.

However, the Trojans proved to be too mighty for the Tigers.
