As an official Emergency Placement Partner with the Humane Society of the United States, PAWS was honored to have been chosen as a partner in our first international rescue on October 1.

PAWS has taken in one canine survivor, Toby, from an unlicensed and illegal dog meat harvesting farm in South Korea. Toby,

along with the other rescued dogs, will finally get to experience what it means to be a cherished and beloved member of a loving, forever family.

Toby is a one-year-old Jindo mix. He weighs almost 30lbs and is roughly 2 ft in length. He has been noted by people for his cheerful and friendly personality.

Toby stepped into the national spotlight when he arrived in North Carolina. He has been featured on national TV with his other dog friends that made this wonderful trip with him. His story has been seen on Good Morning America, CNN, WLOS, and more.

Bringing Toby and others into our N.C. no-kill shelters opens up the shelter to more visitors, which can mean more exposure for our other animals. We are hoping that Toby's rescue will allow our other cats and dogs in our shelter the chance to be adopted. Toby's story also brings awareness to the cruel and inhumane treatment of animals on meat farms in South Korea.


A NATIONAL FUNDRAISING CAMPAIGN FOR PAWS

Sienna Hackshaw is a self-proclaimed animal lover. Her last two birthdays, she's asked for donations to PAWS over gifts. She's even used her Christmas money to sponsor a dog when her parents told her any money she donated they would match.

Sienna's newest PAWS-driven project is the United PAWS of America. Her goal is to get 10 donations per state made to PAWS Animal Shelter - that's 500 donations total! Ashley, Sienna's mom, made the map on the right and Sienna will color in each state as she reaches her goal.

Sienna will be writing letters and sharing map updates as the project gets farther along. She doesn't know how long it will take to meet her goal, but she said she is going to have fun reaching it!

There are no county animal control resources available in Swain County. We live in a rural, economically-depressed area. The result is a perfect storm for animal suffering. PAWS works tirelessly to help as many animals as possible, but the job is too big for one small shelter. Sienna said she wants to help PAWS with funds for additional medical assistance and bring more relief to our local homeless and

The past few months have been busy for PAWS staff. We had puppies come in with severe skin issues that required lots of medical attention and medicine, two day-old kittens were dropped off, we took in two dogs that were heartworm positive, the list goes on and on. PAWS was able to treat and save all of these animals and so many more because of our loyal and devoted donors. They survived and are happy and healthy now because of your support.

PAWS adoptions have increased. This is great news because when adoptions are up, our intakes are up. PAWS has taken in more cats and dogs and provided all their care to get them ready for their adoption. Of course, taking in more animals means that more animals are off the street and safe. What this also means is that PAWS medical and every day expenses for these animals has increased. That's why it is so important to get more people donating on a regular basis. Please consider making a monthly donation or a one-time donation. No amount is too small to help us help the animals of Swain County.

DONATIONS NEEDED

PAWS is hoping to raise \$2,500 to purchase a small utility trailer to haul items to our events. Currently, we have to pack everything into the PAWS van, which leaves very little room to take the animals to adoption events. If we had a trailer, we could store the event items (tables, tents, poster boards, items for sale, etc) in the trailer. It would free up the van, so we could haul more animals to adoption events.

Another large item that PAWS desperately needs is a quarantine building. At this time, PAWS has no quarantine area. We have to quarantine in the med room or bathroom.




