Have I mentioned the incredibly peaceful and lovely presence that is Crestfield Camp and Conference Center? I think we all share the love of the place and the easy access (no steps) all around the three buildings which are incredibly close! If you have ever gone outside at night up there when it is so quiet and dark and there are a million stars out, then you know where I ventured on to the theme of "Into the Mystic". Come and enjoy a few warm and peaceful days relaxing and painting. Old and new friends, welcome!





**Registration:** Registration is in the hallway entrance from the parking lot at Crestfield. You can pull in the circle, unload your car, and then move your car to the parking lot.

We will have use of the "Spirit of the Glen" building and the Scott conference room to paint. Classes will be offered on Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. Registration begins Thursday at 10:00 AM. During check-in, you will receive your nametag, settle your account if need be, and sign up for seating for Sunday's banquet. You must check in prior to going into the class area. If you are staying at Crestfield, you will also receive your room key at the registration desk.

A pizza lunch will be offered at noon on Thursday for those having a 1:30 PM class that day.

#### **Hospitality Room:**

Stop by if you are not in class. Water and small snacks will be available for those who need it.

- All accommodations are in <u>Scott Lodge</u>.
- Rooms are either 2 twin beds or 3 twin beds.
- There is free WiFi (no password needed.)
- Rooms have their own private bathroom, a small dresser, and a table with chairs.
- Everything is on one level, no stairs to climb.
- In the lodge there is a sitting room and a small conference room with tables for those night owls who find themselves awake in the wee hours and wish to paint or read and not disturb their roommates.
- Linens and towels will be provided.

Single and Double rooms are \$94.50 per night. A single person in a 2-bed room will pay \$94.50 per night. Two people would each pay \$47.25 per night.

Triple rooms are \$100 per night. If you have two people in a triple room, the charge would be \$100/2=\$50. If you have three people in a triple room, the charge would be \$100/3=\$33.3 per night.

Meals are served in the dining hall in the main building, just a short walk on the covered walkway from Scott Lodge.

Meals are \$13.00 each. Please add \$3.50 if you would like dessert with any dinner.

We will offer dinner on Thursday, 3 meals on Friday and Saturday, and breakfast on Sunday for a total of 8 meals or \$104.00. However, room and meal packages are available. See page 9.

Breakfast is Friday, Saturday, and Sunday only.
Coffee and light refreshments will be available in the registration/hospitality area daily. A refrigerator and microwave are available for your use. Lunches on Friday and Saturday will be a new Soup & Salad bar!

Cancellations for lodging and meals must be received by October 1, 2025.

Registration will be in the lobby at Scott Lodge. Hospitality and classes will be held in "The Spirit of the Glen"-which is a short walk on a paved path from Scott Lodge. There will also be classes in the conference room in Scott Lodge.

#### **Class Registration Information**

- 1. You do not need to be a member of GTDP to attend the retreat.
- 2. You must use the form provided (or a copy) to register. Please send your registration form with a check to cover all fees to GTDP, % Laura Angelo, P.O. Box 259, Hiller, PA 15444, 724-859-8206, langelo5@icloud.com. PLEASE MAKE ALL CHECKS PAYABLE TO GTDP.

- 3. All fees are to be paid at the time of registration. Along with your registration fee, you must include the teacher fees (4 or 6 hour class). Do not include the project fee. That is to be paid to the teacher the day of the class.
- 4. Enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or e-mail address with your registration. Class confirmations will be returned by snail mail if a self-addressed envelope is provided, otherwise, confirmations will be emailed.
- Only those registered for the retreat may take classes.
   Your multi-day registration fee includes the Sunday Banquet. Banquet tickets are non-transferable.
- List your classes in the order of preference. You will be given your second choice only if your first choice is unavailable.
- 7. Refunds will be made for classes which are cancelled due to insufficient enrollment.
- Refunds will be made to those who cancel their attendance provided a <u>written</u> request is made prior to October 1, 2025.
- 9. Additional classes may be purchased at the registration desk at the retreat, if available.
- A late fee of \$5.00 will be charged if registering after October 1, 2025.
- 11. Crestfield is a smoke-free facility.
- 12. GTDP and/or its teachers will not be responsible for any person's allergic reaction to class materials.
