
St. Pins Tenth CATHOLIC CHURCH

Introduction to Liturgy of the Word

- -Sirach 27:4-7 Praise no one before he speaks.
- -Psalm 92 "Lord, it is good to give thanks to you."
- -1 Corinthians 15:54–58 God gives us victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
- **-Luke 6:39–45** From the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks.

We begin our journey into God's word today with some ancient proverbs, collected by Sirach to teach morality. What we say and what we do reveal the kind of person we are. Paul explains that because of Jesus, sin has been defeated and death cannot win in the end. In the Gospel, Jesus warns his disciples about being blind to one's own sins while at the same time judging others for theirs. May today's readings lead us to examine our words and actions and reflect on what they reveal to others.




