Vineyard and Terroir

- Location: Rondekop Vineyards, situated 200 220 meters above sea level
- Soil Type: Predominantly Glenrosa (Lithic group) soil forms
- Viticulture Practices: The vineyards are extremely wind-exposed, leading to thick-skinned berries that deliver very concentrated juice, ensuring the wine's structure and intensity.



Winemaking

- Harvest: Grapes were sourced from low-yielding vineyards (3-4 tons/ha) and handpicked to ensure quality.
- Vinification: The juice was fermented with local yeasts and underwent maceration for 5 weeks. Maturation took place in 100% new 225L Sylvain and Taransaud French oak barrels with at least three rackings over a 24-month period.





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Tasting Notes

- Appearance: Deep ruby color.
- **Aroma:** Expressions of red berry fruits, hints of cedarwood, and tobacco leaf.
- Palate: The palate shows great texture and elegance, with flavors that will further develop with time.
- Finish: A refined and lingering finish with fruit and earthy undertones.

• **Recommended Pairings:** Enjoy this wine with roast duck, lightly grilled steak, or stews.



Sustainable Practices and Certifications

- Vergelegen is a pioneer in sustainability and biodiversity efforts:
- Awarded the Sustainable Wine Tourism Practices prize in the 2024 Best of Wine Tourism Awards, demonstrating its commitment to eco-friendly winemaking.
- The estate was the first South African Biodiversity and Wine Initiative Champion in 2005, with sustainability remaining central to all activities. Vergelegen's significant alien vegetation clearing project culminated in a 1900-hectare reserve, granted the same protection status as the Kruger National Park.
- They actively support Fairtrade, reduce carbon emissions, practice land conservation by keeping over 2,000 hectares free from agricultural activity, and are a participant in the Cape Leopard Trust.
