



## WHAT TO BRING

### No more than two (2) suitcases.

1. No more than fourteen (14) hangers of clothing.
2. Results from the TB and HIV tests are preferred at the time of acceptance. These tests can be taken at any local clinic.
3. All necessary fees. Dismissal or withdrawal from the home will result in funds being forfeited.
4. All monies are to be from an approved credit card Visa/MC or cashier cheque or cash or PAD and are non-refundable.
5. A Bible (New King James Version, preferably).
6. Note book(s), two 3-ring binders, 3x5 index cards, lined paper, mechanical pencils, pens and highlighters.
7. Postage stamps and envelopes.
8. Toiletries: toothpaste, toothbrush and holder, floss, alcohol free mouthwash, soap and holder, deodorant, toilet paper (at least 2 – 24 roll packs for the year), shampoo/conditioner, etc. Be mindful, that nothing be brought with alcohol content.
9. Electric Shaver (it is preferred that every man be clean shaven).
10. Bring own laundry detergent/dryer sheets – **if you have allergies.**
11. Laundry is done once per week. Bring enough clothes to last between laundry days.
12. Suit (1), collared dress shirt(s) and tie(s) for any formal occasion; (4-5) casual slacks/jeans for everyday activities; work clothing; (2-5) shorts for summer, (5-10)



plain/non-offensive printed t- shirts preferred; (7-10) undergarments/socks; (1-2) pajamas.

13. (1 pair) Steel-Toed work boots; (1 pair) dress shoes; (2 pairs max.) casual shoes; (1 pair) indoor shoes/slippers (floors are hard and cool).
14. Bath Robe.
15. Twin XL- sized sheet set including 1 fitted sheet, 1 flat sheet and 1 pillowcase.
16. One single bed comforter/duvet and pillow.
17. Towels (2 max.) and washcloths (2 max.).
18. Medical and Dental insurance policies (bring policy numbers or cards, if applicable).
19. Valid ID / Social Insurance Card / Copy of Birth Certificate
20. All petty cash will be kept in a safe and accounted for with receipts.

**I agree and understand that if I decide to withdraw, walk off, or am dismissed from the home, all funds from the initial and monthly fees paid will be forfeited to Goshen Renewal Ministries. I also understand that Goshen Renewal Ministries will not be responsible for any belongings that I may leave behind.**



## WHAT NOT TO BRING

1. Secular Music, IPOD/Disc-man, and Headphones
2. Secular Movies and Travel DVD Player
3. Radios / Computer Games
4. Cell Phones / Computers / Laptops
5. Pictures of Friends (pictures can be of family only)
6. Baggy or Tight fitting clothing
7. Jewelry including Earrings/Body jewelry (wedding bands/necklaces permitted as long as they remain on at all times)
8. Any type of weapons
9. Golf clubs, sport equipment etc.
