Where there is a "two" listed by the bold items above, please give one to each of your student representatives. Let the student contestants know they must register at the state spelling bee competition with a parent, guardian, or a teacher who understands the spelling bee rules.

*Take notice of the deadlines regarding champion and runner-up registration form and participation in the art contest. Deadlines are subject to extensions because of possible inclement weather conditions, Flu, or Covid.

Again this year, we are requesting that you have a third or fourth place student attend in the absence of your champion or runner-up. Please provide these students with the same word list by

origins and countries as your champion and runner-up. They will also need the spelling bee rules that can be located on our website. Some schools had no student representatives present on the stage last year. By providing this opportunity we believe each school should or will have representation at the state spelling bee event. The third or fourth place students will only participate if one of your winning students is not able to compete in Muskogee on Friday, April 22nd.

Please let us know if you are not able to open a particular form or other needed information on our website. I will be glad to send you the requested information separately by an email attachment directly to you. Just let me know and I will get that out to you very quickly.
