Editorial – A Question for Advisory Board Members

To Advisory Board members – When St Clements University started it was a competency based education institution. That is the student either successfully completed their degree requirements or they failed them. In practical terms they had to revise their work and submit it. To be able to issue Transcripts which would enable students to continue their studies with other education institutions a graded system evaluation. One area this did not apply to was Ph.D. dissertations as all Ph.D. dissertations were published in our e-library enabling anyone to question a graduates standard, could read the dissertation themselves. Dr. Campbell who was recently evaluated a Ph.D. felt the grading was required. Thus the question is should we change our 30 year policy and grade Ph.D. Dissertations? All other Doctorate dissertations are graded. I look forward to your comments.

International Advisory Board Meeting Delegate VII – Dr. Shadrach Iornem

Dr. Shadrach Iornem lives in London and Nigeria lecturing in several London Colleges and representing his Father – Professor Dr. David Iornem in the UK. He will be giving a report on the progress of Ecole Surperieure Universitaire St Clements and Commonwealth. This School is based in the Benin Republic West Africa.

Reminder of Dr. Christopher Campbell Degree Evaluation Service

Dr. Christopher Campbell, who is a member of the American Evaluators Association and an International Credential Evaluation Professional, will evaluate St Clements University and SCPU degrees, write an Equivalency to US Standard Report and have the report Apostilled and Notarised in the state of Ohio. Alternatively for an extra fee, a similar report can be written by the American Association for Higher Education and Accreditation. Dr. Campbell is a senior member of the AAHEA. He will accept St Clements University degree papers sent directly to him from St Clements requesting an evaluation.

Other Universities News – Torrens University - Australia

It is the only fully for profit University in Australia and was the “last” University to be chartered by a State Government, in Australia. New Future Universities have to seek National Government registration before they can operate. Torrens University specialises in offering combined degrees:

- MBA – MGPM - Master of Business Management – Master of Global Project Management
- MBA – MPH - Master of Business Management – Master of Public Health
- MGp M – MPH - Master of Global Project Management – Master of Public Health

It has campuses in Adelaide (where it is registered), Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane and the Blue Mountains. They offer Bachelor degrees in Design, Health, Hospitality, Technology and Education. They claim to be Australia’s fastest growing University. It was the last Australian University to be chartered by an Act of Parliament. Future degree issuing institutions have to be licensed by the National Government’s Education Department.
