WELCOME TO THE SILVER LINE

Opening in 2014, Metro's new Silver Line will operate between Wiehle-Reston East station in Virginia and Largo Town Center station in Maryland, making all stops through downtown D.C.

The Silver Line will provide new connections to several of the region's most dynamic and rapidly growing economic centers. Coupled with integrated bus service, the Silver Line's high-quality, high-capacity transit service will give riders new, traffic-free access to employment, entertainment, and shopping opportunities.

Five new Silver Line stations will open in 2014—four in Tysons and one farther west at Wiehle Avenue in Reston. Traveling inbound, Silver Line trains will join the Orange Line at East Falls Church station and travel through downtown D.C. to Large Town Center station, serving all stations along the way, similar to the Orange and Blue Lines.

Getting to Dulles International Airport



When the Silver Line opens in 2014, the new Metrorail service will end at Wiehle-Reston East and will not go to Washington Dulles International Airport. However, there will be

multiple options for taking public transportation to Dulles until the airport rail connection is completed.

metrobus Metrobus Route 5A: Service from L'Enfant Plaza station to Dulles Airport, with stops at Rosslyn station and Herndon-Monroe Park & Ride Lot. Departing every 30-40 minutes, Monday-Friday; every 60 minutes, Saturday and Sunday. Find current fare information at wmata.com/fares.



Fairfax Connector 981 and 983:

Tensor Service from Wiehle-Reston East station to Dulles Airport, with stops at Reston Town Center, Herndon-Monroe Park & Ride Lot and Udvar-Hazy Center (Route 983 only). Service seven days a week. Route 983 departs every 20 minutes; Route 981 departs every 40 minutes. Find current fare information at **fairfaxconnector.com**

★ Washington Flyer. Silver Line Express:

Non-stop service from Wiehle-Reston East station to Dulles Airport. Departing every 15 minutes during peak hours; every 20 minutes at other times. Find current fare information at **washfly.com**.

Coming in 2018:

An extension of the Silver Line will provide Metro riders with a direct connection to Dulles International Airport and beyond.





McLean station is the first of the five new Silver Line stations branching off of the existing system, located two miles from central McLean. Several large employers are nearby.





GREENSBORO



Wiehle-Reston East is the last station of the Silver Line opening in 2014. A multi-level, underground transit center located on the north side of the station is the site of commuter parking and a 10-bay bus terminal. Bus service to Dulles Airport will operate from this station.

METRORAIL SERVICE



SILVER LINE

The new Silver Line will operate between Wiehle-Reston East and Largo Town Center stations, running every six minutes during rush hour and every 12-20 minutes at other times.



ORANGE LINE

During rush hour, Orange Line trains will depart Vienna every six minutes, which is an adjustment due to the expected shift of riders to the Silver Line. All Orange Line trains will travel between Vienna and New Carrollton. The Blue and Silver Lines will travel to Largo Town Center.



BLUE LINE

Blue Line trains will run every 12 minutes throughout the day once Silver Line service begins. During rush hour, two Blue Line trains per hour will be replaced with Yellow Line trains. Some 8-car trains will be added to the Blue Line to provide additional capacity.

METROALERTS

SMARTRIP®

The SmarTrip® card provides you with the most cost-effective and convenient way to ride Metro. A



SmarTrip® card is a permanent, rechargeable card used to pay Metrorail and local bus fares, as well as parking at Metro facilities.

It's easy to buy a SmarTrip® card. Purchase your card online or at any Metrorail station or Metro sales office, as well as at select retail outlets and commuter stores.

Using a SmarTrip® card will save you money. On Metrorail, each trip taken with a SmarTrip® card costs \$1 less than those taken with a paper farecard—a savings of \$2 per round-trip! And SmarTrip® is the only way to take advantage of cost-saving transfer options between Metrobus and Metrorail.

Register your card for Auto Reload online to avoid waiting in line at the fare machines. Auto Reload charges your credit card whenever the balance drops below \$10 or an existing pass is about to expire.
