Retailers

Suppliers

In which the person owns, manages, or otherwise represents a company that supplies retail florists, greenhouses, and/or garden centers

Mass Marketers

In which the company has a full-service floral department

Independent Designers

In which the person works independently within the floral industry.

Out of State Florist
