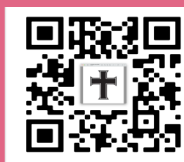


El Santuario de los Pobladores

Our promise and dedication towards completing the Santuario in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. Gravel has been spread in front and around the east and west sides of the labyrinth. Trees (6) have been planted. As donations are received, more trees will be placed. We have also planted shrubs and flower bushes and surrounded the area with gravel. Adobe dedication plaques are now in place in the labyrinth courtyard and placement of plaques continue. Once all these are in place, merchants who have supported our project, will also be acknowledged. Each outlying mission will have its own mission statue displayed when funds are available. Please support the volunteers seeking contributions from your placita. Your continued patience & cooperation is greatly appreciated as we work with volunteers in this phase of our project. St. Augustine & Holy Family statues are now in place at the Santuario. In addition, statues of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego will be placed at the entrance and donations are being accepted to begin this phase. Placement of new trees will also be available to contributors interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos. 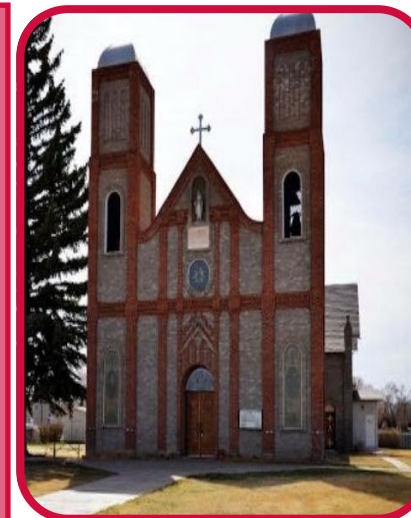

SCAN TO DONATE

Theme: God's Call and Our Response.

In the Catholic tradition, the idea of vocation (calling) was very much restricted to priesthood and religious life. We should not forget that this special call rests upon the general call, which is basic to all Christians, namely, the call to a new existence.

Today's Liturgy deals with the call of Abraham. Both Abraham's call and your own imply three elements. The first is God's free choice. "Not according to our works but according to his own design" (Second Reading); "it was love of you" (Gn 7:7-8). The second is a mission, which could entail leaving the safe, the familiar, the known, and accepting the new and untried. "Bear your share of the hardship for the gospel" (Second Reading). As a Christian, you do have a mission to your family, your parish, your community, coworkers on your job, fellow students in school, friends. The third is a promise, which in Abraham's case consisted of a posterity-children: "I will make of you a great nation" (First Reading). In the case of Christians it consists of life and immortality (Second Reading).

An appreciative fidelity to your calling requires faith. The promises are real but cannot yet be verified as the Gospel of the Transfiguration brings out: "When the disciples raised their eyes, they saw no one else but Jesus alone." "O God... be pleased, we pray, to nourish us inwardly by your word, that, with spiritual sight made pure, we may rejoice to behold your Glory"

FIRST READING Gn 12:1-4a

[Mission of Abraham]

Paul uses Abraham as the paradigm of Christian faith (Rom 4:18-25). Abraham never questioned or doubted God's promise. He went as the Lord directed him. God calls you in the history of your life. All his works are trustworthy, as we sing in the Responsorial Psalm. Stanza two refers to the promise. (Fear means "filial respect.") Stanza three could be your answer.

SECOND READING 2 Tm 1:8b-10

[Design of God]

God has saved you and called you to a holy life. Fidelity to this call may entail hardship, especially when you have to be among people who live more or less unholy lives. Do you have the courage to be different? Think of the promises!

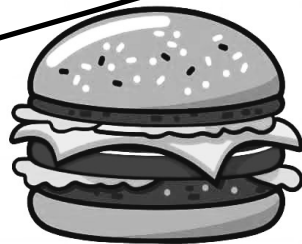
