ORDINANCE No. 994.

An ordinance calling a special election of the electors of the city of Garnett, Kansas, for submitting to them the question of issuing bonds of said city in the sum of Thirty Thousand dollars (30,000.00) for the purpose of making improvements to the water works system for the city of Garnett, Kansas, and fixing the time and place for holding said special election.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GARNETT, KANSAS:

Section 1: That a special election be called, and that the same be held in the city of Garnett, Kansas, on Tuesday, the 20th. day of December, 1927, at the voting places in said city as shall be designated for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said city the proposition to issue bonds of said city in the sum of Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) for the purpose of making improvements to the water works system for the city of Garnett, Kansas, and its inhabitants.

Section 2. That said special election shall be held in the city of Garnett, Kansas at the places and in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication once in the official paper, as provided by law.
