Harvey Edwin Foote, 76, of Sand Point died Monday morning, July 24, 2000, at his home under hospice care. He was born Feb. 22, 1924, in Missouri to the late Stanley and Ellen (Soule) Foote. On Dec. 30, 1942, he was united in marriage to Lola Robinson in Staddard, Ohio. Harvey was a truck driver and worked for Michigan Birch Doors in Mount Clemens, retiring in 1986 after 16 years of service. Prior to that he farmed for many years in Argyle Township.
