<u>Presentation Title:</u> Beyond Binary: Care of Gender Diverse Children and Youth for the Child Life Specialist

<u>Description</u>: This presentation will differentiate natal sex, gender identity, gender expression, and sexual orientation. Participants will learn clinical guidelines in the care of gender diverse children and youth as well as considerations in the care of gender diverse children and youth for the child life specialist. The presenter will discuss affirmative, culturally humble, and strength-based clinical approaches to gender diverse children and youth.

<u>Bio:</u> Dr. Chulani is Section Chief of Adolescent Medicine at Phoenix Children's Hospital and Medical Director of Phoenix Children's Gender Management Service. He is also Associate Professor of Pediatrics in the Department of Child Health, University of Arizona College of Medicine-Phoenix. He completed his pediatric residency training at Maimonides Medical Center, Brooklyn, New York and clinical and research fellowships in Adolescent Medicine at Children's Hospital Los Angeles and his Masters in Medical Education from the University of Southern California – Keck School of Medicine. His clinical and research interests include adolescent sexual and reproductive health and the care of gay, lesbian, bisexual transgender and questioning (LGBTQ) youth. Dr. Chulani's contribution to promoting access to care and health equity for medically underserved adolescents, including LGBTQ youth, has been recognized through numerous awards, including the American Academy of Pediatrics- Promising Practices Award for Promoting Adolescents' Strengths and the American Academy of Pediatrics Special Achievement Award. He has also lectured nationally and internationally on a host of topics related to adolescent health.
