Psalms 46:10-11

What images come to your mind as you think of a family praying together?

Why do we have to have a crisis to pray together?

What is prayer? “To entreat or petition.” Webster’s Dictionary-

One author speaks of prayer as “*entering the silence. There is a quiet place within us all and by silently saying over and over, ‘peace be still,’ we shall enter that quiet place and a great stillness will pervade out whole being.*”
