# THIS MONTH AT PRESCHOOL/THEME

As we start our third month of school, our students are beginning to explore oceans. Your child will have opportunities to discover new concepts about sea life as they peruse the classroom books.



They can experiment with colours, textures, and images of the sea as they construct a gluing craft or try out their painting skills. As always, our playdough toys and tools change regularly, and provide students with a very tactile way to explore new ideas.

# **LEARNING THROUGH PLAY**

Are you wondering why playdough is such an important staple in our classroom? Here are a few things your child gains from this satisfying sensory experience. Playdough can help childre to:

• Develop hand, eye, arm and body coordination, and strengthen finger and hand muscles through squeezing, patting, pounding, rolling, poking, pinching, and cutting with scissors
