

The purpose of the MCSC-SEL camp was to provide evidence-based enrichment through the introduction and implementation of a social-emotional learning curriculum during the academic summer of 2021.

Over the course of 6 weeks, 15 incoming 7th grade students students were introduced to the Collaborative for Academic, Social, and Emotional Learning (CASEL) curriculum. The five competencies associated with CASEL (self-awareness, self-management, responsible decision making, relationship skills, and social awareness) were introduced using foundational elements of Milieu therapy, meaning, students actively learned from one another with the assistance of licensed school social workers (LSSW) introducing and instructing lessons, guidelines, and activities regarding CASEL competencies.

A token economy system was implemented for behavior management for all students involved. The reward for appropriate behavior was a "field-trip" to different Chicagoland and Northwest Indiana facilities.



Throughout the MCSC-SEL camp, students were able to comprehend and implement the core elements of each of the five CASEL standards. Students celebrated their efforts at the end of July with a baseball game at the Gary Railcats Stadium, as well as an award ceremony for their outstanding achievements.













Pre on. Port Test












Quantitative Data Example


































Daily Schedule - Monday/Thursday

- 11:15 am: Check and Connect Assessing students emotional affect
- 11:45 am: Mindful Minutes Utilizing relaxation activities to achieve optimal arousal
- 12:00 pm: SEL Education Assisting students comprehend/implement specific SEL competencies
- 1:00 pm: Pirate on a Mission Learning and reflecting on foundational elements of field trips
- 1:15 pm: Structured Free Time Students were given the opportunity to socialize with peers, engage in low-contact physical activities (i.e. touch football, basketball), or remain indoors to use art materials
- 2:00 pm: Mindful Debrief Students assessed their overall emotional affect from the days events utilizing a "high/low" activity
- 2:15 pm: Dismissal Students were escorted to their respective busses








Stipulations: Students will be awarded "Activity Points" and "Pirate Points." Students earn anywhere from 0-3 points based on each daily activity.


- Students who average 80% or higher attend the field trip.
- Students who fall between 60%-79% will be allowed to justify their eligibility for the "field trip" by identifying which IDOE/CASEL competency they will address in the coming week.
- Students who average a score of 59% or lower will not be allowed to participate in the "field trip." If a student earns a weekly average of 59% or lower an additional week, that student may be removed from SEL summer program.









