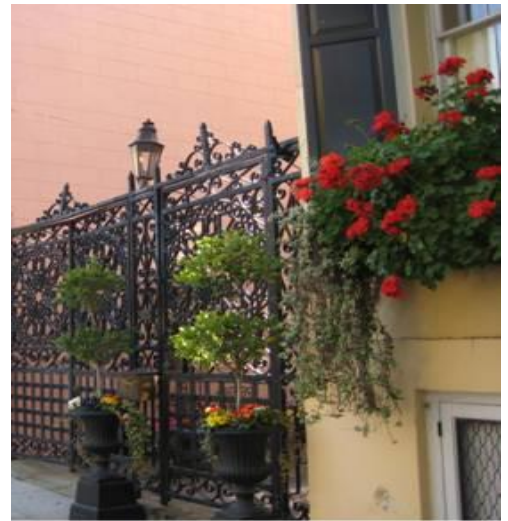
### ENCHANTING CHARLESTON/SAVANNAH MOTORCOACH TOUR

Visit the beautiful Middleton Plantation just outside of Charleston, whose gardens will be in full bloom. See cobblestone streets lined with centuries-old homes and gardens in lovely Charleston. Enroute to Savannah, a stop in Beaufort for a delightful horse and carriage ride around this coastal town with scenic seaside views and homes. Enjoy Savannah's famous hospitality, her many historic squares and handsome town houses plus a stop at Tybee Lighthouse. Good food and fine hotels are all a part of this experience!

#### ITINERARY

##### **Day 1 - OSHER LIFELONG LEARNING WILM./NEW BERN, NC (L & D)**

Morning departure takes us south over the Chesapeake Bay Bridge and Tunnel to Norfolk for lunch at the **Free Mason Abbey Restaurant**. Continue to New Bern for overnight with **dinner at a local restaurant**. Have an evening stroll along the marina by our hotel.

**DOUBLETREE HOTEL, NEW BERN**

##### **Day 2 - NEW BERN/CHARLESTON (B & L)**

Travel south to **Middleton Plantation**, arriving in time for lunch and guided tours of the gardens and the Plantation, a National Historic landmark. Neglected for years after the Civil War, a direct descendant inherited the Plantation and he and his bride spent many years restoring the extensive gardens and main house. Continue into Charleston to our hotel for two nights in the historic area .

##### **Day 3 - CHARLESTON SIGHTSEEING (B & D)**

Our local guide will join us this morning for a tour of this delightful city with colorful historic homes and restored buildings dating back before the Revolution. Visit the beautiful **Edmundston-Alson House**, where construction began in 1820 on a soggy lot purchased by Charles Edmundston, after the city built a sea wall. The house and outbuildings have a very colorful history. Afternoon at leisure to explore on your own before our **delightful evening dinner cruise** with good food and choice of several entrees.

##### **Day 4 - CHARLESTON/BEAUFORT/SAVANNAH (B & D)**

Depart Charleston this morning for the old port town of **Beaufort** (pronounced Bew-fert), about as southern as it can get! First discovered by the Spanish in 1514, the British founded the city in 1711. You'll enjoy a carriage ride with a local guide of this picturesque city before an independent lunch. Travel on to lovely Savannah for two nights in the historic area of the city. Dinner this evening at the well known **45 Bistro**.

**DOUBLETREE HOTEL, SAVANNAH**

**Day 5 - SAVANNAH****(B)**

Savannah, settled in 1733, is a special southern city because of its natural beauty and rich history. Our **local expert Pat**, will join us to tour the **Historic District** laid out around 24 Trust Lots, public areas or squares as we know them today. Our morning tour includes a visit with our guide to the **Cathedral of St. John the Baptist**, built in 1873 with marvelous murals and stained glass windows. This afternoon explore on your own more of this enchanting city's tree-filled squares, the City Market or the River Street Shops.

**DOUBLETREE HOTEL, SAVANNAH****Day 6 - SAVANNAH/RALEIGH, NC****(B & L)**

Pat will join us again this morning for a motorcoach tour through the **Victorian District** with homes built in the 1800 and early 1900 hundreds. In **Arsley Park**, the third district to be developed in Savannah, see homes built by the wealthy in the 1920s and hear entertaining stories of **Savannah in the roaring twenties**. A short drive to **Tybee Island** east of Savannah in the Low Country with a stop at the Tybee Island Lighthouse. Depart Savannah **after lunch** and drive north to Raleigh, NC. Late afternoon check in at our hotel.

**DOUBLE TREE HOTEL, RALEIGH****Day 7 - RALEIGH/HOME****(B & L)**

Depart for home today stopping enroute for lunch. Arrival in Wilmington in the late afternoon.
