





- ✓ Having non-assigned lockers means you may need fewer lockers, as students tend to not need a locker each day.
- Technology integration means no managing keys, scrambling combination locks, or tracking items in spreadsheets.
- ✓ Items like cell phones can be charged and secured inside locker openings, making for distraction-free classrooms.
