Do You Believe In Miracles? By J.P.

In 1998, I had a blood clot go through my heart and into my lung, and ever since that my health has gotten worse. Then in 1999, my mother passed away and if that weren't devastating enough three months later my dad passed away as well. My wife, bless her heart, continued to take care of me. I lost my job in 2004 due to my failing health. Then three days before our anniversary, my wife passed away.

Feeling totally alone and confused I asked God, "What else could possibly happen to me?" Then one month later, my 3 year old grand baby passed away! I quickly became suicidal in my mind. My son, bless his heart, took me in and helped take care of me and even helped me out of that suicidal state.

Fast forwarding a little bit ... I was caught up in something that I perceived as 'trying to do something good' but the Federal Government said I needed to do five years in prison for. Shortly after I arrived here to prison I fell back into that suicidal thinking again. I spent several days just staring out the window, not eating or anything.

Then one day a brother from the Chapel got wind of me and my situation and came to talk with me. When he seen that he was not reaching me, he physically grabbed my wheel chair and TOOK me to the Chapel. Do you believe in miracles? Well, I now do! When this brother parked me in front of that big Cross hanging on the wall, it was like being slapped on the back of the head with a strong feeling of, "WAKE UP! I HAVE THINGS FOR YOU TO DO!" From that moment on all of the suicidal thoughts and depression disappeared! Today I am very happy and I am spreading God's Word where ever I can. All of these events have often caused me to think about Job and the tests that were in his life. Whenever I do, I know that I am in good company. "Praise His name! He has risen!"

This morning we got cell fed, what I like to call "breakfast in bed". As soon as I finished eating I lifted my mat to retrieve the December newsletter. That is where I hid it so I didn't open it early. As I was carefully opening it (it was still completely sealed) I had memories of many Christmas' past when I was a child opening gifts. The first thing I look at is the cover, Glory Meeting and the title of the article on page 3. Right at the top I seen "Hello everyone and Merry Christmas," I was so happy to have waited to open it on Christmas morning and felt the greeting was most appropriate for the moment. I always read the main article through, then come back to the prayer requests, From the Inside, and Foot's study notes section in the middle. I want to thank everyone who helped put this issue together for all the love, hope and support in all the letters contributed in it. I'm not sure where my eyes began to tear up but by the end of the newsletter I had to grab a towel to dry off my face.

"VANN"Tage Point By David E.

Ninety-nine days left, you can officially call me a double digit midget. I will be facing some serious financial obstacles when I get out. \$70,000 in restitution and \$300-\$400 grand in IRS debt. Everyone will want a piece of Vann's arse. Yet, despite all of this, I have always known that somehow God will provide me with a way out, and as I get closer to the gate, as weird as it may sound, I feel His blessings in my life will be presenting themselves in big ways, far larger than the debt that tries to loom over me at this moment.

I know that it will be rough at first, this I am prepared for. I really don't see me as being released, but instead being moved to a much bigger, much cooler yard with lots of food, lots of visits, women and even scooters (and much more!). Financially though I'm locked up. After rent, bike payments, insurance, phone bill and IRS, the money I get from my 9 to 5 will be gone, and will probably remain this way for at least a couple of years, more like a little more than a few. It's all part of my next sentence and I've come to peace with it.

I understand that the reason it's easier for me to accept this is because years ago God made me a free man where it counts the most, and that revelation gives me the strength to persevere through any troubles I face. In order for me to deal with what the world will have to throw at me, I need to stay focused spiritually.

I think I'll need your help. I believe God has put you in my life for a reason, not only as a spiritual advisor, not only as the great friend you have always been, but I believe that as I rise above this adversity and as I come into success on the other side of it, that its testimony will be brought to others through you and your ministry as its conduit. I think that everything I've been through has helped me grow in ways that give me a clear perception needed to deal with the responsibilities that come with wealth and prosperity, as well as the respect used in the distribution of such blessings. I foresee your ministry growing in the aspect also.

First things first though, building foundations to stand on is the first priority, which means a job and transportation.

Don't worry about anything instead pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank Sim for all Sze has done Philippians 4:6 (NLT)

I know that God has a beautiful plan for me, I can almost feel it in all of the favor that He shows me in my life!!! Glory to God! My Abba Father!! I recently got a letter from my last bunkie. She was 24 years old. After she was released she OD'd while on a 10 day relapse. She told me that after that she thought about all of the talks I had with her, the prayers and the love of God in our little 12 foot x 10 foot cell. She remembered me staying up late, getting up early and constantly giving the Lord praise. She said this touched her heart out there on the streets. She checked herself into a rehab and quickly wrote me about how God sent an angel down from heaven and his voice rang through the words I

had spoken to her and she seen how desperately she needed a Savior!!! Praise God!! I'm doing my calling, planting and watering seed. My destiny is to be sure to plant those seeds! When I give my testimony some of these ladies think that I'm bragging, but I'm so grateful He took my old life and restored it 10 times better than it was 16 years ago. It is the love of God that played the part in all of it. My spiritual life has me moving, I'm truly a living, believing, trusting follower of Jesus Christ! ... L.R.

As I am finally approaching my release date after a very long and hard fought 12 years and preparing myself to enter discipleship training, I am compelled to write to you all once again to encourage you while reminding you that God's gracious gift of Salvation does not free us from the requirement for Faithful Obedience.

My fear of rejection was quickly gone soon after my arrival at your services. You see, many moons ago (back in 2006) I made a poor choice and tattooed horns on my forehead.

Anyhow my testimony runs deep! I was the "T" in trouble, so I thank ya'll for your welcome mat. My last service that I got to enjoy was in February of 2013. I got clean that month and that year. But the devil still played his game and anger was soon going to default my freedom. I was arrested for aggravated assault on an officer on March 26th, 2013, but still I claim victory over satan because I'm not dead. He wanted me dead like he wants for most of us. Well, I believe that God and His Wonder Working Power intervened satan's ultimate plan of death for me that day. I am very much alive and effectively helping myself and many others lives while doing my time.

I ran Narcotics Anonymous for a year and helped over 40 brothers get or stay clean and earn their certificates. Yeah with 23 years of (Thank God) "past" addiction experience I feel I was called to do that N.A. group. I call this group the "Never Again Recovery Group". Well, it didn't stop there. I was hospitalized June 14, 2013 and have taken tons of self-help courses such as Anger Management, Cognitive Mnemonics Therapy, Think for a Change class, Better Parenting and a few others. This prison time has been a blessing instead of a burden. I come home in February of 2017. I'd love to get your newsletter sent to me again and I can hardly wait to pull up to the doors of Living Word Bible Church!! I've read and believe these to be true, "The devil cannot enter a home uninvited." Thank you for your time, God Bless

It's a Small World By C.P.

I am 27 years old. I am serving a 25-year sentence for second degree murder. I've been locked up since July 9, 2013. I've never been to jail or prison in my life until now. It's hard for me to adjust to my new prison world. I'm on a Maximum yard. We're locked down 23 hours a day with one hour for recreation. Sometimes we don't even get our recreation due to "ICS" which means the whole prison is locked down for some security reason. My mom's best friend was here in prison with me, she went home already, but she's the one that handed me the newsletters she got from you all.

I was happy to see it was from Living Word Bible Church. I went to that church since I was 16 years old, until I was 25 years old. I stopped going because I relocated to Phoenix and didn't have transportation to get there. I told many people about that church and how I got saved for the first time and that I got water baptized in the Child Kingdom area. My sister-in-law Nelly who has my daughter Yesenia attends church services with you all. I introduced her to the LWBC.

I would like to be added to your list for the newsletter monthly. I enjoyed reading all the stories, testimonies and prayer requests. I would love to learn more about the Word of God. I'm building my relationship closer with God. He saved me by me coming to prison. I would have been dead if I was on the outs. Thank you SG46 for doing what you all do!

Prayer Warriors By B.E.

I love Jesus and pray, read my Bible and fellowship when asked. I have a prayer warrior squad of four people, we pray together in agreement every night at 8:45 p.m. There are three of my homeboys in here and a prayer warrior 'D' out there. My alarm goes off every night at that time and my boys are ready. We give it up to the Lord and rebuke satan and his evil works and lift up everyone and do our thing.

Real prayer warriors ... we love it and feed off it. Jesus is love and we get filled with the Holy Spirit. We're all hardcore believers in the power of prayer. It's awesome cause all of us are ex-gangsters and we meet up again, and I see the Holy Spirit in us.

Foot's Bible Study Rotes

2 Kings 13:1-16:20

Receiving the full benefits of God's plan for our lives requires us to receive and obey God's commands fully. If we don't follow God's complete instructions, we should not be surprised that His full benefits and blessings are not present. (13:15-19)

Material prosperity is not always an indication of God's blessings. It can also be a result of self-centeredness. This book showed me that finding the Lord in prison is the whole point. I am a new believer, who is fighting the odds of this place to become more Christ-like and live by the Lord's Law. I have a Bible and am currently doing a very intense Bible study from Exodus Prison Ministry. I find it very hard to avoid back sliding. My entire life has been lived with a lot of sin and I have lost just about everything. I believe I've gone through all that to find the Lord.
