September Update

Dear Parents,

I hope this letter finds you well and I would like to take the opportunity to update you on the move. This week we have received visits from the Director of British Trade Office (UK Embassy team), Civil Defence and the Ministry of Education. All have been thoroughly impressed with the facilities of our new school and the progress we have made. We have received all the required initial clearances from Civil Defence and Ministry of Education, we are just waiting to receive the official paperwork. In addition, we are still waiting to receive six containers of school resources that have cleared Customs and are awaiting delivery. We hope this will happen Sunday and Monday of next week.

Presently the construction team are still working through a number of snagging issues to ensure the site is completely safe and the building will be reviewed constantly as we settle in.

At this time I can confirm we will open the uniform shop to parents on the 10th and 11th September from 8 am to 1 pm (Tuesday and Wednesday), however this will be in a controlled zone due to the ongoing work in the school. We will not be able to meet with anyone at this time. Parents will be asked to park outside the school.

We are currently working on the new drop off and pick up routines, however, these will be changeable as there is other construction work going on outside of the school. We will send the new routines to parents in due course once we have received agreements from all parties around us.

I am still aiming to open the school to pupils on the 16th but depending how next week works with the receipt of permissions, equipment installation and final snagging we may have to stagger the start for pupils. I do not want this to be a prolonged event as we need to have the pupils in school as soon as possible.
