

Elkton Merchant Dies at 82

Frederick Ginter Was Early Resident

ELKTON — Frederick Ginter, 82, retired Elkton merchant, died Saturday afternoon at his home in Elkton following a brief illness.

A resident of Elkton for 70 years, he was born Oct. 10, 1873, in Canada. Surviving are his widow, Elizabeth; two daughters, Mrs. Alton Schultz and Miss Irene Ginter, both of Elkton, a son, John of Detroit, three grandchildren, two greatgrandchildren; two sister and two brothers.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon in St. Paul's Evangelical United Brethren church. Rev. William Heller, pastor of the Missionary church, will officiate. Burial will be in the Riverside cemetery.
