The Best Life Possible (John 3:1-6) - You Must Be "Born Again" By The Preacher

"Nost assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." (John 3:3)

But what does "Born Again" mean?

A religious man named Nicodemus came to Jesus at night saying he was convinced that Jesus must be from God because of the miracles that He had performed. I assume that conversation was more than the few moments that it takes to read this whole passage. But Scripture mentions only the most important aspect of this meeting.

The Lord told Nicodemus that he must be "Born Again," no matter how religious or how good he was. Then this man of the Pharisees asked Jesus how he could enter back in to his mother's womb and be born again. Jesus then explains that there are two births:

1) The first is a physical birth when one is born of a parent's seed, making him a flesh and blood child of his parents.

2) The second is a spiritual birth when one is born of God's Seed, the Holy Spirit, making him a child of God.

In the Gospel of John 1:12-13, Jesus explains it further, "But as many as received Him (Jesus Christ), to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: Who were born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, BUT OF GOD." And in 1 Peter 1:23, Peter expands upon this with these enlightening words, "Having been born again, not of corruptible seed but of incorruptible, through the Word of God which lives and abides forever."

There comes a time in a person's life when he or she MUST be real with Almighty God, their eternal Creator. Then repent of his or her sins and trust Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. At that EXACT moment in time, God sends His Seed, the promised Holy Spirit, to fill that hole in our soul which NOTHING else we've ever tried has ever nor will ever work. That's when we are "Born Again" into the family of God and become new creations in Christ (*2 Corinthians 5:17*). Because that man or woman is now a member of God's eternal family, he or she now gets the inheritance of eternal life WITH our Father, in heaven!

But why must I be "Born Again?"

Listen closely ...

"For we MUST ALL appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each of us may receive what is due us for the things done while in the body, whether good OR bad." (2 Corinthians 5:10)

"As it has been appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment." (Hebrews 9:27)

"The wages of sin is death, but the Gift of God is eternal life IN CHRIST JESUS our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begation Son, that whoever believes in Him should HOT perish but have starnel life." (John 3:16)

"For God did NOT send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world THROUCH HIM MICHT BE SAVED." (John 3:17)

"For by grace you have been saved THROUGH FAITH, and that NOT of yourselves; it is the GIFT of God, not by works, lest anyone should boast." (Ephesians 2:8-9)

John 3:16 IS the Gospel of Christ in a nutshell and probably the verse memorized more than any other. In a few words it tells the story of Salvation and why we need to be "Born Again"; God's Love for the world; God's Gift of His Son; the opportunity for ANYONE who believes in Jesus to be saved from judgment AND to receive eternal life. This IS the Grace of God! (*Ephesians 2:8-9*) Now, let's dissect this Scripture.

"For by grace ..." Grace is the unmerited favor and undeserved kindness of God. God has given us the greatest Gift in history, His beloved Son, Jesus. And God gives us the gift of loving kindness and tender mercy IF we put our trust in His Son Jesus. "... you have been saved..." We have been saved from sin AND it's penalty, which is eternal separation from God. "... through faith ..." Let's read these 3 verses.

1) "A man is justified by faith APART from the deeds of the law." (Romans 3:28)

 "Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God THROUGH our Lord Jesus Christ." (Romans 5:1)

"For you are all sons of God THROUGH FAITH IN CHRIST JESUS." (Galatians 3:26)

"...and that NOT of yourselves ... " A sinner CANNOT save him or herself from sin, AND we ALL have sinned! So we ALL need a Savior! All of our 'good works' and 'achievements' are not enough to exchange for eternal life in heaven. Mark 8:36-37 tells us. "What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul?"

"...it is the gift of God ... " God's gift of Salvation is FREE to us BY FAITH, because Jesus paid for this gift on the Cross. Jesus IS THE GIFT! (Remember, a gift is not a gift if we have to pay for it!)

"... not by works ..." Salvation is something that happens to us on the inside, NOT by some outward acts of 'good works." "Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us." (Titus 3:5)

"...lest anyone should boast." No one can brag that they made it to heaven because of something that 'they' have done - Not Billy Graham, not Pastor Walt, NOBODY!! We can only boast in Jesus and what He did for us ALL on the Cross over 2,000 years ago. "Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? No, but by the law of faith. Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith APART from the deeds of the law." (Romans 3:27-28) "But God forbid that I should boast EXCEPT in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world." (Galatians 6:14)

Foot's Bible Study Rotes

2 Chronicles 8:11-13:22

Although Solomon carefully followed God's instructions for building the temple and offering sacrifices (8:13), he paid no attention to what God said about marrying pagan women. His sin in marrying a foreign wife (8:11) began his slide away from God. No matter how good or spiritual we are in most areas of life, one un-surrendered area can begin a downfall. Guard carefully every area of your life, especially, your relationships. Don't give sin any foothold. (8:15)

The good times show God's love and faithfulness, but hard times come to believers, too. Our perseverance and steadfast hope during those times will demonstrate our love and faithfulness to God. (9:8)

As Christians we should never rationalize away God's teachings in order to gain earthly reward. (11:16)

How ironic that the pure gold of Solomon's temple was replaced by cheaper bronze. Rehoboam tried to maintain the trappings and appearance of former glory, but he couldn't measure up. When God is no longer central in our lives, maintaining the appearance of a Christian life becomes superficial. Outer beauty must come from inner strength. (12:10-11)

Consider carefully the things you cherish. If you value anything more than God, it becomes your golden calf and will one day drag you down. Let go of anything that interferes with your relationship with God. (13:8)

Romans 8:9-39

The Holy Spirit is God's promise or guarantee of eternal life for those who believe in Him. The Spirit is within us now by faith, and by faith we are certain to live with Christ forever. (8:11)

Sin has caused all creation to fall from the perfect state in which God created it. The world is in bondage to death and decay so that it cannot fulfill its intended purpose. One day all creation will be liberated and transformed. Until that time it waits in eager expectation for the resurrection of God's children. (8:19-22)

As a believer, you are not left to your own resources to cope with problems. Even when you don't know the right words to pray, the Holy Spirit prays with and for you, and God answers. With God helping you pray, you don't need to be afraid to come before Him. Ask the Holy Spirit to intercede for you in harmony with God's own will. Then, when you bring your requests to God, trust that He will always do what is best. (8:26-27)

Psalm 18:16-36

Some people think that belief in God is a crutch for weak people who cannot make it on their own. God is indeed a shield to protect us when we are too weak to face certain trials by ourselves., but He does not want us to remain weak. He strengthens, protects, and guides us in order to send us back into an evil world to fight for Him. And then He continues to work with us because the strongest person on earth is infinitely weaker than God and needs His help. David was not a coward, he was a mighty warrior who, even with all his armies and weapons, knew that only God could ultimately protect and save him. (18:30)

Proverbs 19:26

As an abusive son is shameful, so an obedient son is faithful and successful. (19:26)

The One true God, our Lord, had created EVERYTHING that was in the very beginning of His Word.
