DNA Tests and Help Establishing Paternity

There are two ways that paternity can be established in Indiana. The mother and father can swear to an affidavit affirming the parentage, or the mother, father or child can file a paternity lawsuit. Ruppert & Schaefer, P.C., can help you in either case.

A paternity test is always recommended and no longer involves a blood sample. Instead, a sample of DNA is taken from the mouths of the man, mother and the child in a completely painless procedure.
