Lifesteps Foundation: Furniture for Inclusion Classroom

Recently a grant was given to the **Lifesteps Foundation** to purchase classroom furniture. At the Lifesteps preschool, children with special needs are integrated into an inclusive program. The program is for children with a disability to attend school with their "typically" developing peers. This grant allowed Lifesteps to purchase chairs, tables, and other classroom furniture for the children to have materials that would support their ability to learn in the classroom.

Cynthia Fong-Wan, Project Director, expressed their gratitude for the grant. "We received a grant from Millbrae Community Foundation to purchase furniture for the classroom to support the needs of children under 5 who have a disability. The children were so excited to be able to sit in chairs that supported their learning in table activities or circle time. This has helped children with a disability engage with their peers in the



classroom. The teachers were excited as some of the children in our classroom who have lower muscle tone were able to sit with support in the new chairs. Having child-sized sofas in the classroom has also allowed teachers and parents to sit with the children and read to them."
