WATERCOLOR TUTORIAL FOR BEGINNERS WITH ELLEN ZIMET



REQUIRED: WATERCOLOR BASICS -COLOR by Jan Kunz will be used as the basis for the class – Purchase on Amazon in the USED BOOK SECTION.

This is the 2nd half of a Beginner's Watercolor class. Students will work from the Watercolor Book.

Jan Kunz was the leading watercolorist that began the videoing and how-to books on Watercolor in the late 90's. We will learn the basics and more.

****READ CHAPTER ONE BEFORE CLASS to learn about materials to bring.**

WEEK ONE -Learning about materials and Learning about color. You will make a color wheel and a value chart. And paint a scene.

WEEK TWO: -Project 5, 6, 7 and the painting on Page 50

WEEK THREE: Projects 9, 10, 11

WEEK FOUR: Projects 13 and 14

WEEK FIVE: Project 15 and your choice from pg. 99 on.

MATERIALS: What you will need: Paint –: 3 warms – Cadmium Red, Cadmium Yellow,, and Cobalt Blue – 3 cools- Lemon Yellow, Alizarin Red, Ultramarine Blue – Additionally, Burnt Umber and Burnt Sienna- Cadmium Orange and Hooker's Green. Always buy Artist's Quality Paint (NEVER STUDENT Quality)

Paper: 140 lb. cold press Fabriano (we sell for \$4.00 a sheet) and Arches for 8. One sheet of paper can make 6 paintings.- 3 brushes – 1"flat, #8 and #10 round. Palette for mixing colors – water container- 2B pencil – kneaded or white eraser – xacto knife, box of kleenex (not a square) washcloth or small towel and/or paper towels -masking tape- ruler – graphite paper and tracing paper.

I will supply handouts for all the projects.. There will be a \$5.00 materials charge which will include a package of painting repros. Graphite and tracing paper.
